The x-ray showed a possible Salter Type 1 fracture, and he was referred to an orthopaedic specialist. Caden went to Ozark Orthopaedics on 11/14/2022 and was diagnosed with [REDACTED]. He was provided a walking boot and ordered to have a follow-up in two weeks. [REDACTED] reported that last year he twisted his ankle at school. It is unknown when the healing fracture occurred. Date of occurrence: unknown Corrective Action taken by the agency or follow up done: X-ray was completed in house as a precautionary measure.
