Pt had just finished using the bathroom and was about to come out when he collapsed on the floor. Staff immediately responded to check on pt. One staff member paged for a "Nurse Stat" to Rose House. The other staff stayed with the pt. Pt stated that he was hot and that he felt nauseous as staff asked pt if he needed to continue to lay there or if he wanted assistance getting up and/or sitting up. Staff sat on the floor with pt until he felt he was ready to get up. Pt stated he was ready to get up, so staff got a rolling chair and assisted pt with getting up off the floor and into the chair. Staff rolled pt to the front milieu area and then up to the nurses' station for nursing staff to access pt. IR Nursing Assessment date/time: 12/21/2022 2:00am: Staff reported that client had fallen to the floor, possibly fainting. Upon this writer's arrival, client was sitting in a chair in the nursing office responding appropriately to questioning from LPN staff. Client appeared slightly drowsy but alert and oriented x3. Pupils are equal and reactive to light. Bp-92/52, Temp 97.7, Pulse 90, Pulse ox 99% and Resp 20. There are hives noted to bilateral lower extremities mostly on uppers thighs. Client has full range of motion in all extremities without restrictions or complaint. Client reportedly bumped head during the fall but no bleeding or swelling noted at this time. LPN received orders from on-call APN to administer [REDACTED] by mouth x1 now and transfer client to ACH ER for further evaluation. Client is being prepared for transport at this time. Guardian was notified on 12/21/2022 at 9:00am

Interim Action Narrative: Resident was assessed by nursing and transported to AR Children's Hospital for further evaluation.
