## Primary Narrative By David Guarno, 04/18/23 16:11

### DISTURBANCE

On 4/18/2023, at 15:05 hours I was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn in reference to a disturbance. Upon arrival, I met with the caller, Christian Spratt. C. Spratt advised that he was attempting to calm down an angry student, later identified as \_\_\_\_\_ when he was struck on the right side of his face. He advised that \_\_\_\_\_ was attempting to get away from his grasp and turned toward him, striking him on the right side of his face with a closed fist.

C. Spratt advised that Youth Home had already made arrangements to have \_\_\_\_\_ transported to an Acute Care facility in Maumelle and requested I standby during this transaction. It was also requested that I not speak with \_\_\_\_\_ as he was currently calm and sleeping and staff did not want to see him get worked up again.

It should be noted that Youth Home staff specifically stated they wished not to press criminal charges against \_\_\_\_\_ and that they had already made all arrangements for alternative treatment.

MEMS unit 338 arrived and transported \_\_\_\_\_ per the request of Youth Home Staff.
