Description:

On 4/26/23 a report was received from Arkansas State Police Investigator Deidre Uselton in regards to a new report.

The DHS snapshot was reviewed and the following is a summary of the report.

AV is [REDACTED], who is in DHS custody and is a patient at the Perimeter Behavioral Health of the Ozarks. AO is unknown. [REDACTED] said that the facility is a violent place. She said people at the facility have hit her, but she did not specify staff members or other patients. She was asked if she feels safe at her facility. She said she does not feel safe there, because someone at the facility has touched her on her vaginal area. She did not say whether the person who touched her was a patient or a staff member, but she said the touching was not consensual. She did not give an age for the person who touched her or give a timeframe for when it happened. Reporter was asked if [REDACTED] seemed to be referring to an incident that has already been reported, and reporter said, "no.". Reporter said [REDACTED] seemed nervous to talk about what happened because facility chaperones were present with her as she spoke.

State Police Investigator, Deidre Uselton conducted the interview on the victim, [REDACTED]. Below is her narrative:

04/26 @ 9:00am

Inv. Uselton conducted a recorded forensic interview with [REDACTED]. Inv. Uselton built rapport and [REDACTED] acknowledged she had met Inv. Uselton before. [REDACTED] then asked, "did someone call DHS because of what I told my Dr. about not feeling safe?" Inv. Uselton then asked [REDACTED] what made her feel unsafe. [REDACTED] said that she almost got into a fight with another resident because she was cursing at [REDACTED] and because she lies on her. [REDACTED] explained that this girl has been "eating at her" and she finally had enough. [REDACTED] said her caseworker will not move her out of here until she gets all her phases, and she is still on phase one. [REDACTED] was asked since the last time Inv. Uselton was here to speak with her (2190373) has anyone given her a touch on her body that was not ok. [REDACTED] said no. [REDACTED] was asked what makes her feel unsafe at Perimeter. [REDACTED] stated that it is all the stuff happening at the facility with other residents. [REDACTED] said that the other residents are rude, cussing, and threaten to beat her ass. [REDACTED] said that she got in a fight with a girl and then other residents got in fights and then were kicked out of the facility. [REDACTED] said that she does see her caseworker and the last time was last month. She said she normally talks to her on the phone also, but she has not been answering the phone lately. [REDACTED] became emotional and discussed that she has nobody to go home too. She said her dad went back to using drugs so she cannot live with him. [REDACTED] made no disclosure of abuse and clarified again she did not want to be at Perimeter anymore. [REDACTED] denied that the staff had done anything to make her feel unsafe.

04/27 @ 11:

Inv. Uselton conducted a recorded forensic interview with [REDACTED]. Inv. Uselton asked [REDACTED] if she remembered them speaking yesterday and [REDACTED] acknowledged this. Inv. Uselton explained the room and asked [REDACTED] if anything happened after there meeting yesterday that made her feel unsafe and [REDACTED] said she asked to eat with the staff, and they told her no but then she saw some other residents eating with them and it made her cry. [REDACTED] said she ate lunch alone. [REDACTED] was asked what made her feel unsafe at Perimeter and she said that she gets into fights and the staff does not say anything or make them stop. [REDACTED] talked about a time right after she got to the facility and that she got into a fight with someone and got a "red sheet." [REDACTED] said a red sheet is what happens when you get in trouble and the other girl did not get a red sheet. [REDACTED] was asked if any staff or any resident had given her a touch on her body that was not ok, and [REDACTED] said no. [REDACTED] was asked if there was anything she thought of since we spoke yesterday that she forgot to tell Inv. Uselton and she said no. [REDACTED] was asked about food in the facility and she said that she has plenty of food but gets a little hungry at night and the little snack they get is not enough. [REDACTED] said she would tell her caseworker, Mona, or Inv. Uselton if something happened that was not ok.

Description:

The victim, [REDACTED] made no disclosure of anybody touching her inappropriately like what was stated in the initial hotline. She talked about not feeling safe at perimeter because of the other residents, not the staff. There was nothing illegal disclosed during her interview. this case can be closed, no charges.
