Runaway Juvenile

On (4/29/23), at approximately 1820 hours, I was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road (youth home), in reference to a runaway juvenile. Youth home staff were attempting to locate juvenile **approximately** approximately 1 mile west of the youth home on Colonel Glenn Road upon my arrival. Myself and Dep. Burke assisted in searching the area, but we did not locate the juvenile. I then met with youth home employee, Lamont Ramirez. Lamont stated that the juvenile had fled the Crestview House. Lamont provided information to complete a missing person entry form. Communications was notified to enter **a** a runaway into ACIC / NCIC (NIC# M157309343).

Youth home staff advised was observed walking down Colonel Glenn Road, approximately 2 miles west of the youth home as I was leaving the scene. Myself and Deputy Burke located at approximately 1927 hours near Colonel Glenn Road and Leaning Pine Circle. attempted to walk past deputies, and refused to cooperate. I to stop, but she ran across a ditch in an attempt to flee. placed my arm out in an attempt to get had been fleeing through the woods with no shoes previously, leaving me concerned that she may have been injured. Deputy Burke caught up to and grabbed her by the arm. immediately started resisting. I then grabbed other arm in an attempt to gain control. continued to resist, and she was taken to the ground. Once was placed into handcuffs. Deputies made numerous attempts to get on the around to cooperate, but she refused. Myself and Dep. Burke had to carry to the patrol unit as she continued to resist. I placed into leg restraints as we neared the patrol unit, but she was able to escape the leg restraints.

was then placed into the rear of my patrol unit, and MEMS was notified. Sgt. Darr was notified of the use of force as soon as **a secured**. MEMS unit 338 transported **a secured** to Children's Hospital in Little Rock at the youth home's request. **A stated** she wasn't injured, and calmed after speaking with the paramedic. Lt. Gieber met with **a stated** at Children's Hospital to conduct a use of force investigation. Communications was advised to remove from ACIC / NCIC.
