Runaway Juvenile

On (4/29/23), at approximately 1820 hours, I was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road (youth home), in reference to a runaway juvenile. Youth home staff were attempting to locate juvenile [REDACTED] approximately 1 mile west of the youth home on Colonel Glenn Road upon my arrival. Myself and Dep. Burke assisted in searching the area, but we did not locate the juvenile. I then met with youth home employee, Lamont Ramirez. Lamont stated that the juvenile had fled the Crestview House. Lamont provided information to complete a missing person entry form. Communications was notified to enter [REDACTED] as a runaway into ACIC / NCIC (NIC# M157309343).

Youth home staff advised [REDACTED] was observed walking down Colonel Glenn Road, approximately 2 miles west of the youth home as I was leaving the scene. Myself and Deputy Burke located [REDACTED] at approximately 1927 hours near Colonel Glenn Road and Leaning Pine Circle. [REDACTED] attempted to walk past deputies, and refused to cooperate. I placed my arm out in an attempt to get [REDACTED] to stop, but she ran across a ditch in an attempt to flee. [REDACTED] had been fleeing through the woods with no shoes previously, leaving me concerned that she may have been injured. Deputy Burke caught up to [REDACTED] and grabbed her by the arm. [REDACTED] immediately started resisting. I then grabbed [REDACTED] other arm in an attempt to gain control. [REDACTED] continued to resist, and she was taken to the ground. Once on the ground [REDACTED] was placed into handcuffs. Deputies made numerous attempts to get [REDACTED] to cooperate, but she refused. Myself and Dep. Burke had to carry [REDACTED] to the patrol unit as she continued to resist. I placed [REDACTED] into leg restraints as we neared the patrol unit, but she was able to escape the leg restraints.

[REDACTED] was then placed into the rear of my patrol unit, and MEMS was notified. Sgt. Darr was notified of the use of force as soon as [REDACTED] was secured. MEMS unit 338 transported [REDACTED] to Children's Hospital in Little Rock at the youth home's request. [REDACTED] stated she wasn't injured, and calmed after speaking with the paramedic. Lt. Gieber met with [REDACTED] at Children's Hospital to conduct a use of force investigation. Communications was advised to remove [REDACTED] from ACIC / NCIC.
