## Primary Narrative By Kaylon Jones, 05/09/23 16:24

### Battery

On Tuesday May 9, 2023, I Deputy Jones, was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn for a battery that was called in by one of the youth home staff members.

Upon arrival I made contact with Kaitlyn Davis who stated that [redacted] had heard she was going to be put on a special status that wouldn't allow her to play games with the other students. [redacted] then said "I am out of here" and made her way towards the door. Two male employees blocked her exit and she then went to try bite them. That is when Mrs. Davis then grabbed hold of [redacted] to try and restrain her. [redacted] turned and punched Mrs. Davis in the face multiple times and then attempted to bite her. Mrs. Davis was able to avoid being bitten but was grabbed by the collar of her shirt and was then scratched by [redacted] in the eye.

Mrs. Davis had mentioned her vision being blurry but had refused medical and advised Deputies that [redacted] was being transported by MEMS to Methodist Hospital for care and would return to the youth home.

I made contact with the Juvenile Intake Officer and told Deputy Clark what had occurred. I was advised I could cite [redacted] out and she was given a court date of July 11, 2023 at 0900 hours.

I then wrote my ADR which [redacted] was able to sign. I also had Mrs. Davis fill out a witness statement and I then gave a report number to the youth home staff for their records.
