Report Description: Residents Name/DOB: Date/Time of incident: 4/2/2023/ 2:14pm Please describe the incident: Per staff report the resident tampered with the smoke detector triggering the fire alarm and eloped from the facility. Actions Taken: The resident tampered with the smoke detector in the hallway. Once tampered with the smoke detector it triggered the fire alarm unlocking the facility doors. The resident ran down 300-Hall towards the cafeteria and out of the residential lobby. Staff tried to stop the resident and pursed him while on campus grounds. The resident successfully eloped from the facility grounds. FCPD was notified and continued to search for the residents while in the community. The resident was found by FCPD and brought back to campus at 3:55pm. The resident was assessed by the nursing department and appeared to be alert and oriented. The resident did not have any complaints of pain or injury. The resident was placed on elopement precautions and unit restriction. The precautions will be re-evaluated in 72 hours (about 3 days) for safety. Staff and nursing will continue to monitor the resident's interactions while in the milieu. Guardianship: Private **Placement**

Interim Action Narrative: The FCFD and FCPD were called. Upon returned, resident was assessed by the nurse. Resident was placed on elopement precautions and unit restriction.

The Program Coordinator discussed the incident that occurred on 4/2/23 regarding the reported elopement of resident after he tampered with a fire alarm in the hallway of station 2. Video footage of the incident was reviewed from 14:09-14:16.

Video review showed that it was a resident, who initially tampered with the fire alarm on station 2 hallway in which staff were attempting to redirect him at 14:14. The camera shows a short delay before the alarms begin to go off and begins to immediately attempt to elope. Resident can then be seen running down the hallway in an attempt to elope but is stopped by staff and residents exiting the building per the fire protocol. Resident then goes onto the courtyard and enters back into the building from a side door within two minutes and elopes through the front entrance of the building with staff in pursuit.

Video review shows staff attempting to redirect and contain the residents attempting to elope. The police were notified after the elopement of ______, but he was eventually located and returned to the facility.
