Report Description: [REDACTED], State Custody, DOB: 0 [REDACTED] was sent to Dallas County Medical Center for outpatient x-rays. He received an on-site nursing assessment following a physical confrontation with a peer where he was kicked in the face. X-ray report indicates an acute comminuted and displaced nasal bone fracture, greater on the right. The doctor determined no follow up treatment is necessary. He was released to return to the facility.

Interim Action Narrative: Resident was moved to the Tiger Hall.

Licensing Narrative: Client [REDACTED] was sent to Dallas County Medical Center for outpatient x-rays. He received an on-site nursing assessment following a physical confrontation with a peer where he was kicked in the face. X-ray report indicates an acute comminuted and displaced nasal bone fracture, greater on the right. The doctor determined no follow up treatment is necessary. He was released to return to the facility. Facility contacted 5/1/23 and noted that there was no video footage of incident as it occurred

outside. Incident Report and Nurses Note emailed to licensing 5/1/23 regarding this incident. Facility visited 5/3/23. Client [REDACTED] interviewed. When asked about incident last Friday where he [REDACTED] was kicked in the face [REDACTED] gave description of events as follows. Clients from Pine Ridge (where [REDACTED] resides) and Tiger Hall came to the playground and "started stuff". "They" ([REDACTED] and U/K client) attacked [REDACTED] with sticks. [REDACTED] picked up a stick "to defend myself". [REDACTED] continued that later he was hot so was sitting down and KS "football kicked me in the head". [REDACTED] stated that staff ("Mr. Peanut...I think his name is Donald") immediately intervened. [REDACTED] stated that a female staff then took him to the nurse's office and then he went to the ER. [REDACTED] stated that he has a "fractured nose". A [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] (client referred to by [REDACTED] as aggressor) continues to reside with him at Pine Ridge. [REDACTED] stated that he would like to change cottages but only the "higher ups" can do that. [REDACTED] was informed that present company Chris Butler could facilitate a change in cottages. [REDACTED] stated that he would like that. [REDACTED] stated that he felt safe at Millcreek. When asked if [REDACTED] felt comfortable talking to staff if he is in trouble "some staff but not all staff". Client [REDACTED] interviewed. When asked about the incident involving him kicking client AM in the head, [REDACTED] stated that he was playing basketball. Staff told [REDACTED] to get out of the woods. [REDACTED] stated he told client [REDACTED] to get out of the woods. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] "got mad and threw a stick at me so I kicked him in the face". Donald Hargraves was phoned via speakerphone by Chris Butler. Licensing Specialist Clayton DeBoer spoke with Mr. Hargraves who stated he was present for the incident involving [REDACTED] being kicked in the face. Mr. Hargraves stated he immediately intervened, and that staff Jasmine Thompson took [REDACTED] to the nurse's office. Risk Management Chris Butler stated that an alternate cottage placement would be sought for client [REDACTED]. The facility notified licensing that the resident was moved to the Tiger Hall on 5/3/2023.
