Case Narrative

On May 11, 2023, at approximately 6:13 p.m., I was dispatched to 4253 N Crossover Road, Piney Ridge, for the report of a disturbance. The caller, Sabrina McClelland ([REDACTED] w/f), who is a nurse at Piney Ridge called stating that [REDACTED] w/m), who is a patient at Piney Ridge was on scene causing a disturbance. Sabrina stated [REDACTED] assaulted several nurses and stabbed another nurse with a pencil.

I arrived on scene, along with Officer Barnett #453 and Officer McCrae #440 and spoke with Sabrina. I asked her to explain what happened. Sabrina stated [REDACTED] took his medication but for an unknown reason, they were not working. He became increasingly angry and began striking Sabrina. He threw Sabrina and kicked her in the head causing her to feel like she might lose consciousness. [REDACTED] then kicked Sabrina in the leg. Several nurses began trying to assist Sabrina. [REDACTED] was able to get away and began punching and kicking Oscar Maldonado ([REDACTED] h/m), several times causing complaint of pain and injury. Once [REDACTED] broke away from Oscar he then walked past Nurse Kimberly Dodson ([REDACTED] w/f). Kimberly attempted to restrain [REDACTED] but [REDACTED] pulled a pencil from his pocket and stabbed Kimberly in the right arm with the pencil and struck her in the chest and stomach. It should be noted Sabrina walked with a noticeable limp due to being kicked by [REDACTED] and when I felt the back of her head where she was kicked, I could feel swelling, and she was sensitive to me touching the area. Photographs were taken and those will be added to this case file.

Staff was able to get [REDACTED] into a central room and locked the doors keeping him from wandering the facility and causing more damage. Once locked inside that room, [REDACTED] began ripping up multiple chairs located in the room and destroying items. He began ripping cameras from the wall and smashing them as well as a dry erase board totaling approximately \$1200.00 in damages.

After I finished speaking with Sabrina, she walked myself and the other officers to where [REDACTED] was located. I walked into the room, and [REDACTED] was seated in a chair with a pencil in his hand. I asked him to put the pencil down, but he did not. I removed the pencil from his hand, and he was placed under arrest. I placed [REDACTED] in my patrol vehicle and began speaking with Kimberly about her injuries while Officer Barnett spoke with Oscar. See Officer Barnett's report for further details on his interactions.

I asked Kimberly if she could explain what happened. Kimberly stated she was

attempting to help restrain [REDACTED] when he kicked and punched her multiple times. Kimberly stated she then back off and [REDACTED] began walking around and as he walked past her he stabbed her in her upper right arm with a pencil. Kimberly showed me where she was stabbed and there was a wound with what looked like pieces of lead from a pencil inside. I photographed Kimberly and those will be added to this case file.

I was able to contact [REDACTED] father, [REDACTED], via phone and inform him of what was happening. [REDACTED] stated he understood and did not know what else to do with [REDACTED] and putting him in Piney Ridge was already what a felt like a last resort. I explained there would be a court date he would need to attempt to attend but he stated he would likely not be able to because he lives in [REDACTED]. He was advised of the ongoing process and to contact the Police Department if he had further questions.

I then transported [REDACTED] to the Fayetteville Police Department for juvenile processing and to complete a preliminary report. I placed [REDACTED] in interview room number 1 while I completed the preliminary report and monitored him via the camera system. I then transported [REDACTED] to the Juvenile detention center with no other issues.

For the aforementioned, [REDACTED] was charged with Battery 2nd Degree x3 for knowingly and without legal justification, caused physical injury to a person [REDACTED] knew to be an employee of a correctional facility as well as a certified health care provider in performance of their duties. As well as Criminal Mischief 1st degree for purposely and without legal justification destroyed and caused damage to over \$1200.00 worth of equipment inside the Piney Ridge Facility.

Case Supplement

On 05-11-2023, at approximately 1800 hours, I responded to 4253 N. Crossover Rd. (Piney Ridge) for a report of a disturbance. When I arrived, I met with Officer J. Bailey #460. Officer Bailey was speaking with a staff member. Officer Bailey stated he had determined there were charges to arrest [REDACTED]. We entered Piney Ridge and made contact with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was acting calm and went into custody without issue.

After [REDACTED] was placed into the rear of Officer Bailey's patrol vehicle, I spoke with Oscar Maldonado (W/M [REDACTED]). Maldonado is a Behavioral Health Technician with Piney Ridge. Maldonado stated this situation started the night before. [REDACTED] had destroyed some drywall and pulled an outlet out of the wall. Maldonado stated on 5-11 [REDACTED] was not allowed to play and have fun after last night's incident so he became upset. According to Maldonado, [REDACTED] began punching the wall and destroying property. When Staff attempted to restrain [REDACTED] he began to fight with them. Maldonado attempted to take [REDACTED] to the ground and [REDACTED] was striking him in the leg.

[REDACTED] ended up destroying three cameras, a dry-erase board, and several chairs. The approximate cost of repair for the cameras was \$300 each. The dry-erase board cost \$150. The chairs approximately cost \$150. Photos were not able to be collected of the damages to the property due to Piney Ridge police. They asked, after the arrest, us to exit the building and finalize taking the report so other patients could continue to use the building.

This incident was recorded on my Axon body-worn camera.
