Relationship: Smith works for Perimeter, where [REDACTED] is a patient.

On 05/18/2023 at approximately 1651 hours I, Officer Stuck #325, responded to Perimeter of the Ozarks, 2466 S 48th St., in reference to a delayed Battery report. The caller stated she had been attacked by a patient the night before.

Upon my arrival I made contact with Amber Smith (W/F DOB: 08/03/1989). Smith, who works with Perimeter, stated that on 05/17/2023 at approximately 1930 hours, she was called to assist in restraining a female patient, who was in the process of self harming. The patient, [REDACTED], had been there November, and is there because of self harm and suicidal ideations. Smith stated that [REDACTED] had somehow gotten a piece of a pen cap, or possibly the spring from inside a click pen, and was scratching herself on her forearm. As Smith and the other staff entered and attempted to restrain [REDACTED] she began to resist them. Smith described [REDACTED] as manic, and in one of her regular fits. Smith took [REDACTED] arm and put it behind her back, and as she did, the piece of the pen [REDACTED] had in her hand, nicked the tip of Smith's left thumb, causing it to bleed. [REDACTED] was then successfully restrained.

During the struggle, [REDACTED] had been bleeding, and Smith's fingers intermingled with [REDACTED] blood. Smith went to the hospital and was cleaned up and checked for contamination before being quickly released. Smith stated she wanted to press charges against [REDACTED] because of the contamination of the blood. Smith stated that this is regular behavior for [REDACTED] as she constantly resists any attempt to restrain her, which happens frequently. She stated she did not feel that [REDACTED] harmed her on purpose, or had any other intention than to harm herself and resist the staff as they attempted to gain control of her. I advised Smith I would file a report and gave her the report number.

I asked the staff if they would bring out [REDACTED] so I could speak with her. I called JDC and advised them of the situation and the charges. I spoke with JDC intake officer Munoz, who advised me to cite [REDACTED] and provided me with a Washington County JDC court date of 07/05/2023 at 0900 hours, with Division 3. I spoke with [REDACTED] and advised her of the court date and the charges. I changed the phone number and address information on her citation and she signed it, stating she understood and would appear on her court date. I was unable to change the court to JDC in my ecite module, and I issued a paper ticket. [REDACTED] was issued citation number 407747 for Battery 3rd Degree. I spoke with the staff charged with her care and provided them the copy of her citation. [REDACTED] legal guardian lives in Pocahontas, and she is in the custody of Perimeter, and they advised they will make sure her guardian is advised and she makes her court date.
