[REDACTED] was in the dayroom, she asked to take a self time-out after earning correctives for throwing a milk to another client. She went into the hallway, instead of going to the designated area staff assigned and sat in front of the entrance door. The housekeeping staff was inside of the exam room cleaning, housekeeping open the exam room door to exit the room. One housekeeper was mopping the floor and the other housekeeper stepped in the hallway with the cart waiting for the other worker to finish mopping. [REDACTED] stands up, and walked over to the cart grabbing a bottle with cleaning chemicals off the cart. The housekeeper was trying to prevent [REDACTED] from grabbing items off the cart, but [REDACTED] was able to grab a bottle. Mr. Casey (staff) was present in the hallway at the time of the incident and tried to retrieve the bottle but was unable to get the bottle out of [REDACTED] hand. [REDACTED] unscrewed the lid off the bottle and drank some of the liquid. Ms. Delores (staff) was walking in the hallway when the incident was occurring and retrieved the bottle out of [REDACTED]'s hand. Nurse Stephanie was notified to come assess the client. [REDACTED] was transported to Arkansas Children's Hospital by MEMs around 8:15 a.m. [REDACTED] returned from the hospital around 10:35 a.m., [REDACTED] did not sustain any injuries from ingesting the chemical. Client was placed on line of sight 24/7, finger foods, no sharps and no sporks.
