APRN ordered client to be seen by the Emergency Department. Nursing Assessment date/time: 05/31/23 10:30am: Assessed Pt at this time for continual complaints of headaches and topical pain to her head. Pt has voiced multiple times to peers staff, and mother that she feels like she has a concussion from altercation on Monday were she received head injury. Pt states she has felt "nauseous at times" but no actual vomiting. Pt neuro checks completed at this time. A,A,Ox4, PERRLA, Recent and Remote memory intact, Gait WNL. Notified Provider of findings, Provider advised that is she was still symptomatic to send to ER for further evaluation 2nd Nursing Assessment date and time: 05/31/23 2:30pm: Client returned from ACH ER around 8:40pm on 05/31 with diagnosis of [REDACTED] No concussion was detected. Client is alert and oriented, calm and cooperative. Client denies blurry/double vision, steady gait, answers questions appropriately. Client states she does have a headache 5/10, but adds that it is probably because she is "using too much ice for my head". States she does get dizzy at times, while playing outdoors, encouraged to take frequent breaks/rest and get plenty of fluids. Client states she is not angry with peers at this time. No other needs identified now, will continue to monitor. Guardian was notified on 05/31/23 at 11:10am, 3:30pm: [REDACTED] was sent to ACH ER instead of Urgent Care for evaluation incase of the need for a CAT Scan, that procedure would only be available at the ER. Notified Mother at 1110am that with the continual

multiple complaints that the provider would like to send her for evaluation and to be medically cleared. Notified Mother at 330p that [REDACTED] was being transported at this time to ACH ER for evaluation and to keep her phone on and near incase they called her for information/consents Guardian was notified on [REDACTED] return from the ER on 05/31/23 at 1:50pm
