Description:

On 6/1/23 a report was received from Arkansas State Police Investigator Logan Woynaroski in regards to a new report.

The DHS snapshot was reviewed and the following is a summary of the report.

AV is 13yo [REDACTED], who is in the Texas foster care system and currently in care at Perimeter of the Ozarks in Springdale. On 5/23/2023, at 2:43 AM, Av was attempting to activate the fire alarms at the facility so she could elope from the facility. Staff tried to stop her. She threatened to assault staff. She attacked a nurse and other staff members. She had to be restrained. She was redirected multiple times, but she continued to assault staff. Staff spoke to a doctor, who authorized her to have 'emergency medication.' Once the emergency medication was administered, she was able to calm down and go to bed. On 5/24/2023, she was involved in another incident and had to be separated from a peer. She again became violent with staff and was once again restrained. She received medication again to calm her down. Speaking about the incidents later, [REDACTED] said that she was restrained by only male staff. She said that when they restrained her on 5/23/2023, they choked her with a sweater, and she could not breathe. She said the restraint left bruises on her knees and arms

Description:

On June 1st approx. 1200, CACD Investigator Logan with State Police contacted me in reference to setting up an interview with the victim at the Children's Safety Center. He stated that he scheduled the interview for today at 1400 hours. Below is Logan's narrative:

██████████ was interviewed by Inv. Logan Woynaroski at Perimeter Behavioral Health on 06/01/2023. The following is a detailed summary.

After building rapport, Inv. Woynaroski asked ██████████ if she knew why he was there to speak with her. ██████████ did not know, and Woynaroski asked ██████████ about living at Perimeter. ██████████ advised that an incident had occurred on a Monday either a week or two weeks ago where she had to be restrained and could not breathe.

██████████ advised that herself and two other residents had tried to pull the fire alarms in an attempt to leave Perimeter. The attempt failed, and ██████████ and the other residents were told they would need to go to an isolation room. The residents refused, and they were told they would be restrained. "Nurse ██████████ tried to put ██████████ in a hold, but ██████████ was able to get out and tried to help one of the other residents get out of their hold. ██████████ said "Mr. ██████████ got behind her, put his hands on her shoulders, and tried to put ██████████ in a hold by pulling her back. ██████████ said ██████████ pulled on the material of her jacket, and the fabric of the jacket and her shirt had pulled into her neck. ██████████ said she could not breathe when this occurred and said this to ██████████ who said "I'm not choking her". ██████████ continued to pull on ██████████ shoulders until ██████████ "kicked him (██████████) in the balls" and got out of the hold. ██████████ said ██████████ tried to put her into another hold but was unsuccessful. ██████████ said another male staff member had come up and grabbed her arm, and then Mr. ██████████ grabbed her other arm. The two male staff members then put her into a hold against the wall. ██████████ said she was panicking the entire time and having "flashbacks". ██████████ ran and grabbed the leg of another resident. "Nurse ██████████ said "grab her" and ██████████ was given a shot. After the shot ██████████ went into her room and went to sleep. ██████████ advised this took place in the blind spot of the cameras. This incident occurred in the day room in Green Unit.

██████████ described "Mr. ██████████ as short with blonde hair, but she did not know his last name. ██████████ did not know the name of the second staff member and could not provide a physical description beyond "he was big". Both staff members work the night shift

██████████ said she had bruising on her arms after the incident but advised they had faded. ██████████ could not remember if there were any bruises on her neck.

██████████ said this was the only time an incident like this occurred.

██████████ made no other disclosures of abuse.

Description:

CACD Investigator Logan interviewed the Perimeter Staff member, [REDACTED] that placed the hold on the AV, [REDACTED]. This is his narrative of the interview:

[REDACTED] was interviewed by Inv. Logan Woynaroski at Troop L Headquarters in Lowell, AR. The following is a detailed summary.

[REDACTED] advised the night of the incident was "unique", as the facility was usually quiet during his shift. [REDACTED] said he never had any interaction with AV before [REDACTED] advised that he had placed the AV in a hold after the nurse had unsuccessfully attempted to put AV into a hold and AV had begun attacking him. [REDACTED] advised that he and another staff member had been trying to remove another resident from the wing when AV began to punch, knee, and kick him. [REDACTED] said that no one had come to place AV into a hold, and she was beginning to push up the arms of the resident that [REDACTED] and the other staff member were attempting to remove from the unit. [REDACTED] was worried about AV hurting the resident, so he placed her into a hold with her arms behind her. [REDACTED] denied ever putting his hands on AV's shoulders and pulling her back. [REDACTED] remembered AV screaming that he was choking her, but he denies ever putting her in a position where this occurred. [REDACTED] advised AV was screaming and swearing during the entire incident. [REDACTED] said he eventually managed to sit AV down onto the floor, but AV was able to get out because of the paper that was all over the ground. [REDACTED] advised that AV had grabbed onto another resident's leg and had to be placed into another hold so her medication could be administered. [REDACTED] said he felt bad because he knew holds were traumatizing, but it was a "lose-lose" situation. [REDACTED] advised he had worked in facilities for 38 years and had been an instructor for "Handle with Care" for 3 years.

A PUB-52 and CACD-212 were provided.
