Logan Woynaroski at Perimeter Behavioral Health in Springdale. Detective Hunter Helms and ASP Intern Allison Atkins observed. After building rapport, advised Woynaroski she was in foster care. advised Woynaroski that something had happened with her former and her former roommate refused to tell Woynaroski any details aside from what happened with cocurred more than once, but less than five (5) times, and what happened with occurred one time. of the units. would only say "they raped me", and when asked what "rape" meant, said "sexual things". refused to acknowledge the body safety diagrams.
