Upon arrival I made contact with the victim/caller, he advised that this last Wednesday (06/21/2023) his moped had been stolen from a location on 48th street, he provided me with the title and advised that he doesn't often see mopeds like his so when he saw it being partially hidden in his own neighborhood he found it odd. He snapped a quick photo of the VIN to confirm away from the home and when he knew it was his he called for Police assistance. While waiting for Officers, he observed a W/F exit the home, get into a vehicle and leave the scene.

I ran the VIN of the moped through dispatch to confirm, I was advised it was in the system as stolen. I observed two bungee cords draped over the seat, a bluetooth speaker strapped onto the handle bars, a small metal can attached to the frame with magnets (empty), several combination locks on several parts of the moped and strong magnets near the knocked out ignition. The key hole for the fuel tank had also been bored out for ease of opening without a key. Several wires/connectors were cut or unplugged on the bike.

I took photos of the moped placement, the VIN placard and several items of interest (noted above) which were all uploaded to the server for the file. I advised the owner to get an invoice or receipt of all repairs, the cost of a replacement helmet that had been taken with the bike but no longer with it, and the item that was lodged into the ignition for logging into evidence to the Police department for the case when he has them to be used for restitution purposes.

I made contact at the residence that the bike was parked. I spoke with [REDACTED], he advised that he did not know it was there and denied knowing who may have put it there. Within a couple minutes the vehicle, being driven by a female returned to the home. I spoke with [REDACTED], she also denied knowing that it was parked there or who may have put it there and then as if a light bulb went off she declared "I think I may know, we adopted two little girls from my daughter and her husband a while back. We invited him over yesterday to help put together a bunk bed for the girls. He was here pretty late so we told him he could stay the night. he is known for thefts and drug use." I asked if he was still in the home and they said "yes, he should still be asleep on the couch." I was invited in to make contact and escort him outside to talk.

He identified himself as [REDACTED], I ran him through dispatch which came back with a search waiver on file, a (M) warrant for FTA (fleeing) out of Rogers PD (M2023025670) and a (F) warrant out of the Washington County board of Parole (23004375). [REDACTED] was mirandized and asked about the moped, he denied knowing anything about it. He stated that

he walked there and that all he had in the house was a wallet (no wallet located). [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] provided me with [REDACTED] belongs that were all stacked next to their kitchen counter, a large backpack, a mid-sized drybag, lightweight jacket, ball cap, and two canvas bags attached to the backpack. All of which were heavy.

Due to the active search waiver, I began going through his belongings while waiting for confirmation of his wants/warrants. Several items threw up some red flags. There was a used car dealer AR VL (EX66008), a stack of price label stickers for twenty-five and fifty cents to Harps and another unknown retail store. I know these to be used for price swapping. [REDACTED] had a lot of tools, some gloves and face masks. There were several sets of keys, several broken out ignition parts/pieces. I took the keys he had in his belongings and attempted to unlock the cable lock that was attached to the rear wheel and frame, one of the keys opened the lock. There was also an unlabeled prescription bottle of pills, identified as M. Amphet Salts 25mg (14) and Adderall 30mg (1).

I placed [REDACTED] under arrest for his confirmed warrants, Theft by Receiving (F) and Possession of Controlled Substance (F). I cited (2A0A0931155) [REDACTED] with Christmas day date indicating that the charges will be seen at Washington County Court. I completed his prelim report, logged his property for safe keeping due to being too much to take to WCSO. The VL was returned to the state. The stickers and pills were logged in. I transported [REDACTED] to WCSO on his charges.

The moped was deleted and returned to the owner.
