Report Description: [REDACTED] On 5/21/23 at 1945 [REDACTED] reported to the nurse that a peer was in his room being sexually inappropriate. On 5/24/23 while in a family session with his therapist, [REDACTED] reported that he was rapped by a peer. [REDACTED] was asked to explain by his therapist, and he stated that the peer bent him over and stuck his penis in his butt. [REDACTED] stated that the peer asked him to be his bitch.

Interim Action Narrative: [REDACTED] was moved to Tiger Hall. [REDACTED] remained at Magnolia Hall.

Maltreatment Narrative: Ref# [REDACTED] FAX 6-12-23. AV is [REDACTED]. AO is a peer, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are residents at Millcreek of Arkansas. On 5-21-23, [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] was in his room being sexually inappropriate toward staff by touching himself. [REDACTED] has been bullying [REDACTED] for the past couple of days as well as touching his private area. At that time, nothing else had happened, according to [REDACTED]. On 5-24-23, [REDACTED] reported to his aunt that he had been raped. [REDACTED] states that [REDACTED] bent him over and stuck his penis in his butt. [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] to be his bitch. Recieved email from [REDACTED] 6/13/23 as follows: The AV is [REDACTED]. AO is a peer, [REDACTED]. On 6/13/23, AV [REDACTED] was interviewed, by Inv. Garcia, and disclosed that 2 months ago he was raped by [REDACTED] in the bedroom that they shared together. When asked about that, [REDACTED] disclosed that [REDACTED] pulled down [REDACTED]'s pants and underwear and put his penis in [REDACTED]'s butt twice on the same day. [REDACTED]

advised that [REDACTED] "nutted" ([REDACTED] described this as being "white") and [REDACTED] wiped it off with a Nike grey jacket.

Licensing Narrative: [REDACTED] On 5/21/23 at 1945 [REDACTED] reported to the nurse that a peer was in his room being sexually inappropriate. On 5/24/23 while in a family session with his therapist, [REDACTED] reported that he was rapped by a peer. [REDACTED] was asked to explain by his therapist, and he stated that the peer bent him over and stuck his penis in his butt. [REDACTED] stated that the peer asked him to be his bitch. Facility was phoned by licensing 6/13/23 to inquire about when this incident was reported and when it was reported to licensing. Joretha Bragg, Risk Mgmt. Asst., gave no reasonable explanation as to why [REDACTED] was not called until 6/9/23 for an incident that was reported 5/24/23. Ms. Bragg did state that the clients were separated. [REDACTED] was moved to Tiger Hall. [REDACTED] remained at Magnolia Hall. Chris Butler, Risk Mgmt. of Millcreek was phoned who was on vacation who could provide no reasonable explanation as to why the [REDACTED] was notified untimely. Gregoria Garcia gave permission for licensing to visit facility 6/13/23. Visit was scheduled for 6/14/23. Facility visited 6/14/23. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] interviewed. Facility reports that the camera footage of the unit has been deleted as it is only retained for 14 days. [REDACTED] reported that this incident happened "about a month ago...during the day...while staff were in the dayroom...twice in one day". [REDACTED] reported that this did not happen at any other time. [REDACTED] reported that each time took "about 15 minutes". [REDACTED] reported that at no time during these incidents did staff check on his room. When asked how often staff checked on him in his room "not often". [REDACTED] stated that he felt comfortable talking to staff if he ever felt unsafe. [REDACTED] interviewed. [REDACTED] stated that he understood there was an "accusation" adding that he has never done anything sexual with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that he is not comfortable with talking about anything sexual with [REDACTED] or any other male peers. [REDACTED] stated that staff checked on him and [REDACTED] in their room "about every 15 minutes". [REDACTED] stated that he felt comfortable talking to staff if he ever felt unsafe. Chris Butler of Millcreek reported that after client [REDACTED] first reported this to staff he was moved from Magnolia Hall to Tiger Hall. Client [REDACTED] was placed in a room by himself with precaution of having no roommates. Client [REDACTED] was already and remained on Close Observation and Elopement Precaution which were initiated 5/8/23 for 30 days. This incident was reported by client [REDACTED] to Millcreek staff on 5/24/23. The [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was notified of this incident by facility on 6/12/23. Facility cited 110.9: Any owner, operator, employee, foster parent, or volunteer in a child welfare agency shall immediately notify the Child Abuse Hotline if they have reasonable cause to suspect that a child has been subjected to child maltreatment. 7/28/2023- Licensing received notification that this case has been closed as TRUE. Millcreek was then contacted to determine if the A/O was still residing at the facility. The facility confirmed the alleged offender is still at the facility. The facility provided a safety plan for the resident and have plans to discharge him due to the finding.
