Report Description: AR Mandated Reporter Portal: During the morning shift, patient

became non-compliant when prompted to get out of bed. Staff disengaged from the argument, gives responsibility to another staff member and removed herself from interaction with later reported on a phone call to her parents that she was dragged out of bed and beaten up by staff member discussion. This was reported to have happened on 7/23/23. She reported that she was dragged by her wrists and ankles and her hair was pulled to the point that some strands of hair broke off. Nursing assessment indicates that there was no injury in the areas where discussed that she was hit or harmed. Patient pointed to a pin-point red area on her left inner ankle and one to inside lateral right knee. The allegation was ACCEPTED for investigation by Reference ID: discussed the was immediately placed on administrative leave, pending the results of the

investigation.

Interim Action Narrative: Staff was immediately placed on administrative leave pending investigation.

Maltreatment Narrative: Ref# Allegation: ABUSE- AV stated that during the morning shift that staff person dragged her out of the bed and beat her. It was noted that staff dragged the AV by her wrists, ankles and her hair was pulled to the point that some strands of her hair broke.

Phone call made to Chris Butler of Millcreek 7/24/23 who stated that video was available for the day in question, 7/23/23, but that client has since stated that the incident of physical abuse happened a week, a couple weeks or maybe a month ago. Phone call made 7/24/23 to Jennifer Harper of Ms. Harper scheduled an appointment to meet licensing at Millcreek 7/26/23 at 9:30AM. Received email from Chris Butler of Millcreek 7/24/23 that client is client roommate. The staff member that overheard the allegation of abuse reported to parents on a phone call was . Also indicated is that without a specific time or day (client has changed her report and is unsure of when the event took place), it is not possible to pinpoint staff that may have witnessed the event. Facility visited 7/26/23 in response to complaint that staff member physically harmed her. Licensing made by client attended interview by Investigator Jennifer Harper with client Client reported that about "2 weeks ago...8AM in the morning in the hall between dayrooms, mostly kids around, don't know their names, pulled my hair...then sat on my bed and apologized". At this point was sitting in the hallway and had cursed at another client. stated that she, not , engaged client in stated that she never witnessed attempts to deescalate the situation. have any interaction with client after saying she could not enter her room. added that she had never seen any staff at Millcreek be physically inappropriate with any clients. Staff interviewed during facility visit 7/26/23. stated that she was not aware nor witnessed any physical confrontation between client and staff stated she has never witnessed be physically inappropriate with any clients. Licensing is not prepared to make a finding at

this time, 7/26/23. Received email 11/10/23 that maltreatment report was unfounded.
