Licensing Specialist completed buildings and grounds and observed the following areas: administration hall of EMAC, dorms, rage rooms, dining room areas, common/day areas, comfort corners, grounds, laundry rooms, library, nurse's station, courtyard, hygiene cabinet, storage closets, and the classroom hall.

Upon arrival, Licensing Specialist observed parked cars and vans on the parking lot. Licensing Specialist also observed a mobile clinic truck for Arkansas Children's' Hospital. Licensing Specialist was escorted by Mr. [REDACTED], Program Manager.

EMAC: Staff were observed sitting in the administration hallway in staffing. Licensing Specialist observed housekeeping cleaning the dining room area. Residents were in their classrooms preparing to transition to their next class. Dorms 1, 2, 3, and 4: all bedrooms were organized, and bathrooms were clean. Each dorm had a water pitcher for drinking water. Each resident is supplied with a water bottle that they are allowed to take to class with them. Licensing Specialist observed the following documentation on the walls: menu, emergency escape plan, daily schedule, zone regulations, clients' rights and responsibilities.

EMCC: The nurse was preparing noon medication for the residents. East, North, South, and New Dorm were observed. Licensing Specialist informed that residents have new laundry basket for their clothing. The common area was clean. Housekeeping was cleaning East Dorm during the walkthrough. All bedrooms were organized, and the bathrooms were clean. Laundry was being completed, towels, and bedding was neatly folded on the shelves. In the storage areas and cabinets Licensing Specialist observed hygiene products and activities for the residents.

The area outside where the residents are permitted, the grass was maintained with no safety hazards noted. Licensing Specialist observed metal boxes where fire extinguishers are kept.
