On August 1, 2023, I responded to a disturbance call at Perimeter of the Ozarks. The caller, Elizabeth Benham, told dispatch the fire alarm had gone off and the girls who live there started to become unruly. One of them tried to leave the facility and Elizabeth tried to stop her, and the girl hit her in the head.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Elizabeth outside the front door of the facility. I asked her what had happened, and she said the fire alarm had gone off, which causes the doors to unlock. One of the girls who lives at the facility, who Elizabeth identified as [REDACTED] tried to escape. Elizabeth said she then stepped in front of her to prevent [REDACTED] from leaving the facility. When she did that, Elizabeth said [REDACTED] hit her in the forehead with the palm of her hand and walked off. I asked Elizabeth if it hurt, and she replied it did. She denied medical attention and I could not see any apparent injuries on her head.

I asked Elizabeth several times if she wanted to press charges, and she said she did. I then contacted the Washington County Juvenile Detention Office, who advised [REDACTED] would have a court date of August 22, 2023 at 1:30 pm at 123 N College in Fayetteville. When I was filling out

the Ecite, it would not let me select August 22 as a court date, so I crossed it out on [REDACTED] copy and gave it to one of the directors on site. I also explained the court date and where it would be located to him. I asked him if he wanted me to talk to [REDACTED] and explain it, but he said police presence might get the residents fired up again and he would take care of it.

A written statement was collected from Elizabeth, and when the staff had no more questions for me, contact was ended with them.
