On September 2, 2023, at approximately 6:00 p.m., I, Officer Ryan Johnson, Officer Johnnathen Taylor, and Officer Jacob Murry were dispatched to Millcreek

Behavioral Unit for three runaway male juveniles. Upon my arrival, employees of Millcreek were directing me down the road to where other employees had one juvenile on the ground. Once I got to those employees, they pointed to other employees who had the second juvenile caught. After making sure they had the second juvenile, it was told to us that the third male juvenile ran into the woods across the street from Industrial Drive. Officer Murry and I made contact with the juvenile about 50 yards from the roadway and secured him in handcuffs. We escorted him to my patrol unit, where he was placed in the backseat and taken to his dorm. After dropping him off, I went back and took the first juvenile that was caught back to the same dorm. All three juveniles were dropped off at the dorm, and no further incidents happened.
