## Primary Narrative By Matthew Knobloch, 09/05/23 18:49

Runaway Juvenile

On 9/5/2023, at approximately 1731 hours I, Deputy Knobloch, was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Rd, Little Rock, AR 72210 in regards to a runaway juvenile.

Dispatch advised me that a white female wearing gray pants and a black hoodie had ran away from the youth home and was headed east down Colonel Glenn Rd. I then canvassed the area in an attempt to locate the juvenile. I then observed a female matching the description given walking through a field at Colonel Glenn Rd and Burlingame Rd.

Upon making contact with the female she stated her name was a positive of the youth home because she has felt trapped and just needed to get away. Youth Home worker Chastity Robinson then arrived on scene with other coworkers and transported back to 20400 Colonel Glenn. I then spoke with workers at the youth home and discovered that suffers from Major Depressive Disorder, ADHD, and other behavioral issues.

The Youth Home was provided a report number, parents were contacted via the employees, and no further action was taken.
