On 9/10/23 at about 1800 the patient came to nursing window with a nosebleed. The nurse instructed to do standard actions to make nosebleed stop. Nurse reports patient was smiling and interactive and all of a sudden, her demeanor changes and the patient stated, "I feel dizzy." Instructed to have a seat and to take deep breaths was given fluids. The nurse reports the patient's condition started to look worse with more dizziness, staring gaze, paling skin, and patient becoming diaphoretic. Nurse also reports patient seeming to have an altered level of consciousness but would respond to a loud voice, all vitals within normal limits. The patient was sent to hospital for further evaluation. Corrective Action: ?
