



Report Description: On 09.26.23 around 1550, Supervisor unit D2 to remove the chairs and table. While removing the extra tables and chairs, (DOB: DFPS) and exchanged words (unclear from the audio). kicked the table towards from the unit. Upon returning to the unit, walked toward failed to use a proper PRT single-man restraint to transition the resident to the floor. has no bruises or injuries noted.

Regulation Not Applicable:

The staff at Little Creek used the handle with care restraint as a preventative measure from the resident's physical attack upon the staff member. He proceeded to attack the staff while in the physical hold and then choose to attack two other staff members after the physical hold. The resident has a history of sucker punching or charging at the staff with his hands down. To prevent a physical attack, the staff immediately goes into a handle with care physical hold.
