Narrative:

On Thursday October 5, 2023 after taking a report at Perimeter of the Ozarks, the caller McKenna Sherrill who is the case manager stated that they needed to file a second report.

She stated that two residents got into a fight on October 3rd. I spoke with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that she was attacked by another female [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said that she sat in some water accidentally and [REDACTED] thought it was funny and started to laugh at her. [REDACTED] asked her not to laugh at her because she was having bad day. [REDACTED] walked off, but [REDACTED] returned a little bit later and grabbed [REDACTED] by the hair, got her on the ground and began hitting her. [REDACTED] said she was hit at least 4 times while in the fetal position on the ground before staff seperated them.

There was no visible injury to [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was not interested in providing her side of the story.

Sherrill stated that they conducted an internal investigation and reported the incident to DHS/CPS. There is also video of the incident available if needed.

Description:

On October 16, 2023, I spoke with McKenna Sherill in regards to the two reports she had filed. There were two separate reports involving 4 different individuals. All individuals involved are in DHS custody and are here from other states. I asked her what the purpose of filing the report was, if it was to document the incident or if it was because the other victim parties wished to pursue charges.

She stated that one victim had no interest in pursuing charges and the report was to document only. She stated that [REDACTED], the victim in one report did wish to press charges. It is unknown if that was communicated to the reporting officer, but no charges were filed at that time. Both [REDACTED] and the victim in her case have since been discharged and have returned back to their home state. With all parties being from out of state and in DHS Custody, I will not be able to speak with them.

At this time, with the suspects and victims no longer being present, their DHS status and the fact that they are juvenile, there is nothing further to be done in these matters. These reports will be forwarded to my supervisor for Inactive Case Status Review.
