10/14/23 5:20pm Nursing Assessment date/time: 10/14/23 5:35pm: The patient was in the seclusion room in a personal hold when the nurse got to the Mabee house. The patient entered the seclusion room because she was unhappy and disobeyed staff directives, according to the staff. After being observed hitting her head while in seclusion, the patient was put in a personal restraint. The patient was eventually quiet enough to be taken out of the personal restraint after ten minutes. Patient eventually displayed nurse self-harm scars after initially refusing to allow nurse to examine injuries. The patient had three self-harm marks: one bite mark just above the left wrist, one bite mark that penetrated the flesh on the wrist, and a superficial scar on the left lower arm. Patient rejected all medical attention and did not allow nurse to take vital signs. It was disclosed by the patient to the nurse that the approaching anniversary of her grandfather's passing would make it a difficult month. On-
call physician ordered personal restraint, lock seclusion, unlock seclusion, freeze, FOH, and
eyeball. Mom and UM were informed at 630 p.m. At the table, the patient was playing cards and finishing his dinner with the staff. There are no more issues to report. Guardian was

MEMS present and woke patient up for transport. Patient calm and cooperative and got on the MEMS stretcher/transport device. Guardian was notified on 10/15/23 at 12:35am
