Report Description: Incident Report for DOB: 6 DHS placement client from Clark County in our PRTF program and resides in Mabee House Incident Report date/time: 10/14/2023 8:32am Incident Description: Medical Emergency(Trip to ER/Urgent Care), Patient Injury Staff Involved: Don Rose, Gregory Nesdahl Events Leading: Patient reported to nurse that two days ago she hit her arm against the wall and bruised it. Patient was assessed initially yesterday and today it showed continued discomfort and discoloration, orders received to be evaluated at urgent care. Awaiting staff transport. Nursing Assessment 1 date/time: 10/14/23 9:10am: Patient presents in hallway and calm and cooperative with nurse. Pt right medial aspect of hand noted to show signs of discoloration and bruising. Pt reports difficulty and pain on movement of hand. Cap refill less than 2 seconds. Orders received for urgent care evaluation. Nursing Assessment 2 date/time: 10/14/23 1:00pm: Patient return to Mabee house from ortho Arkansas. Nurse examine patient upon return edema with bruising and discoloration noted to right wrist.. Patient complained about pain when moving the 4th and 5th digits. Patient refused naproxen at that time. Ortho Arkansas had the following results: Per Amanda APRN at ortharkansas patient right wrist is not fractured. Per Amanda patient have some swelling noted to Ulnar side of right wrist. Recommendation include Tylenol, ibuprofen, and wrist brace if one is available. ON call MD notified of ortho Arkansas recommendations patient can not take Ibuprofen due to lithium interaction and patient have an allergy to Tylenol. Patient may have naproxen 550mg twice a day as need. Patient have a follow up appointment scheduled. Patient Caseworker notified of recommendations. Guardian was notified on 10/14/23 at 10:48am
