On Friday October 21, 2023, at 1700 hours I responded to the Perimeter of the Ozarks located at 2466 S 48th St in reference to a welfare check. The caller, [REDACTED] advised that about 50 minutes before she called the police department her husband was on the phone with her daughter, [REDACTED] who is a patient at Perimeter. While on the phone [REDACTED] told her father she had been sexually assaulted. Since the phone call [REDACTED] said she had attempted to contact [REDACTED] multiple times, but since patients couldn't have phones, she was not successful as one from Perimeter would answer the phone. [REDACTED] also stated her husband heard a staff member say they would look into it.

When I arrived on scene the staff acted as if they had not heard of the allegations and didn't know what I was talking about. I let the staff know [REDACTED] mother had called in a welfare check and I needed to speak to her. The staff got her for me and allowed us to use a room away from where the other patients were. I then introduced myself to [REDACTED] and let her know why I was there. I then asked her to tell me about what happened. [REDACTED] proceeded to tell me that on Thursday night (October 19, 2023) her roommate later identified as [REDACTED] had raped her. She continued saying on that night she told her roommate she needed a "sneaky-link" because she thought her boyfriend was cheating on her. She said the two kissed, but that [REDACTED] didn't stop there. She reported [REDACTED] told her she would kill her if she told anyone what happened and continued forcing herself on [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] made her suck on her breast and she reported there was a hickey from her doing it. [REDACTED] also



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reported [REDACTED] had liked her vagina. I asked [REDACTED] if anything else happened or if she was penetrated by [REDACTED] and she said not. Later [REDACTED] brought that back up and said [REDACTED] did stick her fingers in her vagina. She said she denied it previously because she didn't know if fingers counted. It should be noted during my interview with [REDACTED] she became emotional and started to cry while speaking about what happened.

After taking the initial statement from [REDACTED] I contacted my Sgt. who had the on-call detective call me about the incident. Det. Aini called me and I explained what had happened. He then told me he would call me back, and when he did he told me to take the report and that he would not be coming out.

I informed Perimeter no detective would be responding at this time so they made arrangements for [REDACTED] to be moved rooms. Perimeter also provided me with a face sheet for the suspect which was turned into my shift complete box. I gave them the report number along with my work email so they could send me a copy of their child abuse hotline report. I went over the process with [REDACTED] briefly and advised both parties that [REDACTED] mom had stated she was on her way Perimeter from their home in [REDACTED] I then ended my contact with both parties.

At that time, I contacted [REDACTED] about the incident and let her know what actions the PD was taking. She was also given the report number. She told she was on her way to Perimeter and planned to remove [REDACTED] from the facility as she was there voluntarily. I let her know that if she did remove [REDACTED] to contact the detective working case Monday morning to let them know as they would need to be able to speak with [REDACTED] regarding the incident. After answering her questions to the best of my ability I ended my contact.

Perimeter acknowledge they were made aware about an hour before prior to my arrival. They stated they were completing the hotline while I was on scene and would email the referral number but as of 1630 hours on Sunday October 22, 2023 they had not. Because they did not provide me with a referral number I completed a hotline myself and received confirmation # [REDACTED]

As of Wednesday October 25, 2023, my bodycam footage has still not uploaded so I have not been able to review it to see what terms [REDACTED] used when referencing bodyparts or the actions of the suspect, and as a result I used the common names for them in my narrative.



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I have no further information at this time.

Description:

10/27 I called and talked to the victim's mother. A new piece of information I got from the mother was that her daughter told her that the suspect "told her she was going to kill her". I will be contacting the state investigator to see if she has other information on this case.

10/31 I stopped by the Perimeter of the Ozark and got in contact with McKenna Sherill. We agree on me interviewing [REDACTED] on Thursday, 10/2 at 1:30pm. I also received a summary of the victim's interview down in Faulkner County. Here's the summary of the interview:

At the above date and time, [REDACTED] was interviewed by FI Kennedy Holleman at the Faulkner County CAC; the interview was observed by Inv. Lakin Barron. The following is a summary of the interview. For the full details, refer to the DVD. [REDACTED] explained that she goes by [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that her birthday is August 23, 2008. [REDACTED] stated that she went to a facility, Perimeter of the Ozarks, "where it all happened". [REDACTED] said that she was raped. [REDACTED] defined rape as sex without consent. [REDACTED] explained that she moved units and had a roommate named, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said that on Thursday night she allowed [REDACTED] to kiss her, which [REDACTED] specified that she did consent to one kiss, because she suspected that her boyfriend was cheating on her, and she wanted a "sneaky link to cheat back". [REDACTED] stated that she doesn't remember everything that happened. [REDACTED] said that, after the kiss, all she remembers is that she's on a bed and "it" happened. [REDACTED] was asked what she meant by "it", and she wrote "sex" on the board. [REDACTED] stated that she doesn't remember what happened after the kiss, but that she didn't consent to it. [REDACTED] said that she was on the bed and [REDACTED] was on top of her and said, "If you do not do what I say, I'm going to kill you".

11/1 I got new information that the suspect is a foster kid under DHS custody. I am forwarding this report to the Washington County Juvenile Prosecutor for review.

[REDACTED] disclosed that on Thursday night, 10/19/2023, she and [REDACTED] were kissing, and [REDACTED] took things too far. She stated that [REDACTED] grabbed her breast and entered her vagina without consent. [REDACTED] told her to stop and tried to push her away, but she continued. [REDACTED] left hickies on [REDACTED] neck, but there are no other injuries. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have since been



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separated.”
