Report Description: Child's Name: [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]) he is an Arkansas resident in parents custody Description of report: At approx. 1359 this resident was playing football when he fell onto his left hand/wrist area. Resident presented with pain and swelling. X-ray was ordered in house. The x-ray that was performed in house and showed ?Minimal buckle fracture of the distal radial metaphysis? APRN was notified and orders were received to take to Physician Specialty for follow-up. Pain medication and ice was given prior to initial x-ray being done. Date of occurrence: 10/21/2023 Corrective action taken by the agency or follow up done: Resident was taken to Physician's Specialty Group with nurse and BHA. He was seen by Brent Rush NP, he had additional x-rays done and they placed a brace on his left wrist. He was discharged from the ER with instructions to wear the brace and follow-up with Dr. Cox in one week. The hospital called back and said he did not have a break and did not have to wear the brace if he didn't want to. However he still does need to follow-up with Dr. Cox. This referral was sent to our transportation department and the follow-up will be made.
