Report Description: On 05.19.23, [REDACTED] walked off the unit to say "hey to her teacher. [REDACTED] attempted to guide [REDACTED] back to the unit, and [REDACTED] said, "Not to touch me. " then he continued to guide her, and she fell to the floor and sat there. Then [REDACTED] attempted to help [REDACTED] off the ground by picking her up, and when lifted off the ground, her shirt raised, [REDACTED] stated her "boobs are out," and [REDACTED] continued to escort her. [REDACTED] could pull her shirt down and cover herself when on the unit. She then attempted to leave the unit again and was escorted back; while being escorted, [REDACTED] physically attacked the staff by kicking [REDACTED]. He then left the unit to assist in other areas of the building. No injuries noted Called into the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] not accepted. Staff will be retrained in escort through handle with care instructor.

Licensing Narrative: 12/21-Phone call made to Jlynn Perkins of Little Creek to ascertain correct date of incident (12/19/23). Visit scheduled for 12/21/23 to review video. 12/21/23-Facility visited and video reviewed of incident. Staff [REDACTED] observed standing/walking one on one with client [REDACTED] towards Starfish living unit, staff's arms under client [REDACTED] arms. Client [REDACTED] drops to the floor. Staff [REDACTED] then, still having his arms under client's arms,

drags client on the floor into her living unit. Other staff viewed standing within arm's length of this incident and did not assist. Client [REDACTED] was on Unit Restriction, and had left her unit, thus resulting in staff initiating escort. Escort was viewed as inappropriate and possibly physically harmful, as client was dragged on the floor. Facility cited 109.1g: Engaging in behavior that could be viewed as sexual, dangerous, exploitative, or physically harmful to children. 905.4g: The following disciplinary actions shall not be used: g) Physical injury or threat of bodily harm. 12/21/23-Licensing Specialist Clayton DeBoer re-reported this incident to the [REDACTED] and it was not accepted for investigation. Email was sent to Jlynn Perkins of Little Creek indicating that the staff seen in video ([REDACTED]) that witnessed this incident other than [REDACTED] will need to be retrained on proper escorts. Phone call made to Jlynn Perkins who stated that staff [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] will receive retraining from on-site trainer today, 12/21/23. A sign in sheet will be provided to licensing before COB 12/22/23. Training sign-in sheets for staff [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] provided to licensing 12/27/23.
