Reports 23-78333 and 23-78341 were generated at the same time by the same victim involving different incidents at the Perimeter of the Ozarks Facility.

At approx. 2:33 P.M. on 15 December 2023 I, PTL Samuelson, was dispatched to the Perimeter of the Ozarks to speak with 16 year old patient [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said there was an incident in which she was assaulted on Dec 4 (23-78333) and on Dec 10 (23-78341). These incidents involved different suspects.

On 10 December [REDACTED] was in the Day Room Green Unit. [REDACTED] had assaulted her by going for [REDACTED] hair, and hitting her across the face. She received a black eye, swelling, and a busted



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lip. Staff came in and both girls fell to the ground. As [REDACTED] was being restrained, she kicked [REDACTED] in the mouth.

[REDACTED] admitted that [REDACTED] started saying stuff, and [REDACTED] told her to stay out of the conversation. When [REDACTED] threatened to beat [REDACTED] ass, [REDACTED] replied with the same threat to beat [REDACTED] ass before the fight started.

[REDACTED] said she requests to press charges. At the time of incident, staff would not allow her to contact police and said they do not need to get involved. She still lives in the same wing as [REDACTED] and sees her on a regular basis.

[REDACTED] also said she feels like she is being denied her rights to access to contact CPS or her advocate.

After speaking to [REDACTED] I met with Sarah Whorton, the Director of Risk and Quality Management ([REDACTED]). An internal report may have been filed on both incidents. She said she would review their documents and video of both events after the weekend. I informed her that [REDACTED] would like to speak to her patient advocate if that can be arranged.

**Description:**

I, PTL Samuelson, received an e-mail from Sara Whorton [REDACTED] on December 18 with the following statements.

"Results regarding reported incidents:

The first incident actually took place on 12/3/23 not 12/4. We do not have audio, but it can be seen on camera that the two other reported residents did walk up and start hitting [REDACTED] from behind. Staff intervened immediately but both reported residents did get several hits before they were able to be broken up. This took place at 18:28.

The second incident took place on 12/9/23 at 15:47 not on 12/10. [REDACTED] antagonized several residents one after the other for about 10 minutes. The other four did not respond as staff were able to intervene. The reported resident did fight with [REDACTED] after verbal exchange was seen being made on camera. Again, we do not have audio, but the reported resident got up from her chair and hit [REDACTED] which began the fight. Staff were there and broke it up immediately."

1300 hours I emailed Sara Whorton ([REDACTED]) asking for video of the incident.

01/02/23

0823 hours I received an email from Sarah Whorton ([REDACTED])

"Good morning, I did verify that we still have those videos available. We cannot give them out, but you are more than welcome to come view them. My cell phone number is [redacted] our receptionist is out and it makes it hard to get to specific people so just call or text to let me know when you would like to come view them.

0836 hours I called Sarah Whorton. I asked Sarah if I could record a copy of the video footage on my work cell phone. Sarah advised I would not be allowed to do that. I asked Sarah if they would require a subpoena to release the video. Sarah advised she would ask her director and call me back. Sarah did advised they had saved the video since the report was filed and video footage would not expire.

0859 hours I emailed TMiller with WCSO to request a subpoena for video of the incidents as well as incident reports and documentation filed by the facility.

0932 hours Sarah Whorton called back and said corporate advised they would need a subpoena to release the video.

01/03/23

1152 and 1153 hours I received Subpoenas from TMiller which [only] requested video of the incidents.

1218 hours I called Sarah Whorton and asked if I could come in to view and obtain copies of the video.

1300 hours I conducted a follow up at Perimeter at 2466 S 48th St Suite B. Sarah showed me video of the incidents and provided me with a copy of the video footage.

In the second incident Sarah identified [REDACTED] the female wearing a light blue t-shirt with dark long-sleeve shirt underneath and dark shorts. Sarah identified [REDACTED] as the female wearing a tan-colored long sleeve shirt and dark colored pants with spots. After entering into the field of view, [REDACTED] was speaking to a staff member in the hallway for approximately 4-5 minutes. In the video, [REDACTED] appears agitated and walks up to several females. It appears [REDACTED] is attempting to instigate fights but her attempts are blocked by staff. This occurs repeatedly for approximately 10 minutes between [REDACTED] and multiple different females. [REDACTED] has to be blocked and restrained physically by staff several times during this. During this period [REDACTED] walks to the shelves and pulls property off multiple shelves and onto the floor. Sarah identified the property as not belonging to [REDACTED]. During this period, [REDACTED] slams her hand on the door very close to another female's head. It appears [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] exchange words. [REDACTED] begins to push towards [REDACTED] but is pushed back by a staff member. [REDACTED] walks around the staff members and hits [REDACTED] in the head. [REDACTED] grabs [REDACTED] hair with both hands and bicycle kicks [REDACTED] in the shoulders and head. [REDACTED] kicks approximately 6 times.



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Sarah said the only incident reports they file were check box forms and they do not provide much information. Sarah advised corporate advised her not to release the incident reports. Sarah advised none of [REDACTED] injuries had been documented by photographs. Sarah advised [REDACTED] only had a minor scratch on her arm. Sarah advised [REDACTED] did complain of a headache from both incidents.

Sarah said to see or speak with the juvenile suspects I would have to set up a meeting with them and their guardian or case workers.

1043 hours I asked Sarah to speak with the nurse or nurses who treated [REDACTED] after the incidents. Sarah asked that I email her and she would respond to the email with the nurse's information.

1048 hours I sent Sarah an email.

I received an email from Sarah:

"on 12/9- it was Rachel Spohn her phone number is [REDACTED] I verified that on this day it looks like the nurse reported a swollen lip and a small cut on her lip



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on 12/3- it was Karly Ridings her phone number is [REDACTED] I verified that on this day it looks like the nurse reported the small scratch on the right forearm

I know there was some confusion on injury. There are no reports of a black eye"

0936 hours I called [REDACTED] case worker, [REDACTED]. I did not receive an answer and I was unable to leave a voicemail due to the voicemail not being set up.

0940 hours I called [REDACTED] [REDACTED] 'other relation,' [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] answered and said she was a former foster parent but did not have any current involvement with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] provided the area director's contact for the time she fostered [REDACTED] [REDACTED].

0945 hours I received a voicemail advising [REDACTED] was a wrong number.
