Program Coordinator observed a resident on the telephone and two residents in their bedroom. One resident was completing hygiene. Mr. Parker reported one resident being on pass.



All houses were organized and clean. Each house had holiday decoration displayed. Residents appeared to be enjoying their down time. Staff and residents reported the following activities today: eating lunch with their family, making smores, taking pictures with Santa and Mrs. Claus, and receiving candy.
