Primary Narrative By Steven Bass, 01/03/24 21:36

Disturbance

On 1-3-2024 at approximately 1833 hours I, Deputy Bass, was flagged down at the Youth Home located at 24000 Colonel Glenn Rd by staff in reference to a disturbance.

I made contact with Kierra Taylor and Michael Tucker, staff at Youth Home. They advised that [redacted] had been disruptive, and tried calling 911 multiple times due to receiving a punishment for bad behavior. Kierra stated that [redacted] continued being disruptive, and yanked the phone off the wall. Kierra stated that they went to place [redacted] into a hold/restraint to prevent [redacted] from damaging other property or hurting [redacted] or others.

Kierra stated that when they went to restrain [redacted] began thrashing, and as a result, ended up kicking Kierra in the stomach area. Kierra and Michael stated that [redacted] then began to spit at staff members before eventually calming down, and complying with staff.

I observed Kierra's stomach, and noted no red marks/abrasions/swelling to indicate a major physical blow/strike was made. I photographed Kierra for the report. I then spoke with [redacted] with staff present.

[redacted] stated that [redacted] was upset because [redacted] was not allowed to have a snack in the normal designated area. [redacted] complained that staff never follows their own rules. I advised [redacted] that where [redacted] has snack is not staff breaking a rule, nor does it warrant poor behavior, calling 911, etc. [redacted] was not receptive, and began yelling at myself, and staff.

I advised staff that I would document the incident, and advised them to contact the Sheriff's Office if needed in the future. I provided them the report number for the incident, and returned to service.
