## Primary Narrative By Daniel Sousa, 01/09/24 20:15

### Runaway Juvenile

On January 9, 2024, at 1808 hours, I, Deputy Sousa, was dispatched to the Youth Home, 20400 Colonel Glenn Road, in reference to a runaway juvenile who returned. I made contact with the reporting person, Kierra Taylor via phone.

Taylor stated the juvenile, [REDACTED] was "Over-Stimulated" because she and her girlfriend who stays at the Youth Home as well had broken up, and that the ex-girlfriend looked at [REDACTED] wrong. Taylor stated that [REDACTED] was upset and broke out of the Youth Home and then was located a few moments later by a nurse near a shed.

While on the phone with Taylor she stated that [REDACTED] told the staff that she drank chemicals that were behind the shed. Taylor stated that they were having [REDACTED] transported to the hospital.

I responded to the Youth Home and spoke with Taylor. I observed the front door and appeared it had no damage. Taylor stated that the door is secured by a magnet and if you hit it just right it would open.

I made contact with [REDACTED] I asked [REDACTED] what was going on and she stated that she was upset. I asked [REDACTED] where she ran to and she stated down the street behind a shed. I asked [REDACTED] if she drank any chemicals and she stated no. I told [REDACTED] that I was told by the staff that she did drink some chemicals behind the shed and she stated she did not drink it but got some in her mouth. [REDACTED] stated that she climbed over a shelf in the shed instead of opening the door and she fell from climbing over the shelf causing the chemical to spill into her mouth.

MEMs 75 transported [REDACTED] to Children's Hospital.

I made contact with the nurse, Joseph Davis. Davis stated that an "all-call alarm" went out and he started to help look for [REDACTED] Davis stated that he located [REDACTED] in the tree line next to a residence at, 20175 Colonel Glenn Road. Davis assisted her back to the Youth Home. I asked Davis if he located [REDACTED] at the shed and he stated the tree line near the shed.

I did not observe any evidence that the Youth Home is not taking care of the children.

I completed an Arkansas-mandated reporter portal (1203735214).

I provided Taylor with a copy of the report number.

Nothing further
