**Report Description:** [REDACTED] disclosed to her therapist on 01.25.24 that there was a boundary issue with a peer on 01.24.24. [REDACTED] was taking a shower on the unit, and a peer walked in on her and began to help her bathe. [REDACTED] screamed and told the peer, "I do not need help." Reported: [REDACTED]

**Interim Action Narrative:** The [REDACTED] was called.

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**Maltreatment Narrative:** The av is [REDACTED]. She lives with guardian [REDACTED]. The ao is [REDACTED]. They are both placed at Little Creek Behavioral Health residentially. [REDACTED] was in the shower Unknown entered the shower. [REDACTED] helped her take a shower and touched her inappropriately. [REDACTED] was touched her in vaginal area by [REDACTED] [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that she helped her wash other body parts also. There was no penetration. [REDACTED] indicated that this was unwanted contact. They were in the shower for about 5 minutes together. [REDACTED] said she told [REDACTED] to get out. [REDACTED] would not leave when she was told to leave. This happened on 1-24-24 @ 1230 pm.

Per Jlynn Perkins of Little Creek, camera footage previously reviewed which revealed staff [REDACTED] clearly allow client [REDACTED] to enter shower area where [REDACTED] was showering. Clients [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have been separated and assigned different living units. Staff [REDACTED] will be terminated subsequent current administrative leave. Facility cited 907.2: Childcare staff shall be responsible for providing the level of supervision and care necessary to ensure the safety and well-being of each child at the facility, taking into account the child's age, individual differences and abilities, surrounding circumstances, hazards, and risks. Licensing complaint is founded. 1/30/2024, Program Coordinator inquired about training for staff on showering procedures. 2/5/2024, Program Coordinator followed-up with facility to see if training has been completed and requested documentation. Facility reported that staff members were informed of the shower policy and provided a copy of the policy. 3/1/2024, Program Coordinator checked CHRIS case is still pending.
