Disturbance

On January 25, 2024, at approximately 1330 hours, I, Deputy Couch, was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road (Youth Home) in reference to a disturbance with a juvenile.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Staff workers who advised that [redacted] was causing a disturbance and had damaged the frame inside the closet area. Staff informed me that they had to hold [redacted] down to prevent [redacted] from causing more damage to the facility. I then made contact with [redacted] in the hallway, and [redacted] advised me that [redacted] did not want to be there because [redacted] did not have a good vibe about the place. I asked [redacted] why [redacted] felt that way, and [redacted] stated that [redacted] wanted to return to the home where [redacted] came from because it felt like a family, and [redacted] got along well with the other youth and staff. [redacted] advised that [redacted] time at home was not yet up and that [redacted] was upset that [redacted] had to leave and come to a place that did not feel comfortable. I asked [redacted] if [redacted] felt uncomfortable about the employees at the Youth Home, and [redacted] stated that they were friendly people and that [redacted] did not like the facility because it did not feel like home.

[redacted] stated that [redacted] would continue to give them a hard time and damage the facility until they removed [redacted] from the Youth Home. I explained to [redacted] that causing a disturbance would not get [redacted] what [redacted] wanted and that [redacted] needed to speak with [redacted] case manager regarding the issue that [redacted] was having.

Staff members were advised to call the Sheriff's Office if [redacted] behavior became irate. They were given the report number and advised a report would be on file at the Sheriff's Office. Staff advised that they would contact caseworker for further instructions.
