## Primary Narrative By Javonn Couch, 01/25/24 15:58

Disturbance

On January 25, 2024, at approximately 1330 hours, I, Deputy Couch, was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road (Youth Home) in reference to a disturbance with a juvenile.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Staff workers who advised that was causing a disturbance and had damaged the frame inside the closet area. Staff informed me that they had to hold down to prevent from causing more damage to the facility. I then made contact with in the hallway, and advised me that not want to be there because did not have a good vibe about the place. I asked whv felt that way, and stated that wanted to return to the home where came from because it felt like a family, and got along well with the other youth and staff. advised that time at home was not yet up and that was upset that to leave and come to a place that did not feel comfortable. I asked felt uncomfortable about the employees at did not like the facility because it did not the Youth Home, and stated that they were friendly people and that feel like home.

stated that would continue to give them a hard time and damage the facility until they removed from the Youth Home. I explained to that causing a disturbance would not get what wanted and that needed to speak with case manager regarding the issue that was having.

Staff members were advised to call the Sheriff's Office if behavior became irate. They were given the report number and advised a report would be on file at the Sheriff's Office. Staff advised that they would contact caseworker for further instructions.
