Narrative - Morgan, Don - 2/11/2024 10:51:49 AM (Initial)

On 2/11/2024 I Officer Morgan was given a name and number by dispatch to return a call to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] advised that she had picked up her grandson [REDACTED] from the DACUS Center in Bono. Pratt advised that [REDACTED] had been the victim of sexual misconduct while in the facility. [REDACTED] stated that she reported it to the facility but has not heard back from them. She wanted to make sure it was reported to State Police. Information was gathered and a report was submitted to CACD. Confirmation #32521506

I spoke with Whitney Jones and Andrea Burns with the Arkansas State Police. They informed me that is currently under investigation. I shared our witness statement with them from the victim. Andrea Burns stated she will follow up with Bono PD.

After reviewing the information of this case. I have ammended the charges from 5-14-110 to 5-14-124 Sexual Assault 1st Degree.

Narrative - Mccracken, Joel - 2/16/2024 12:29:59 PM (Initial)

Andrea Burns from Arkansas State Police came to Bono PD to do a joint interview of our suspect [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] denied all claims of a sexual realizations. See AXON body came footage for full interview. Andrea Burns will be trying to gain access to the centers video camera footage. We will be continuing this joint investigation.

Andrea also gave us copies of interviews with victim and reports. I also shared with her our witness statement from victim and will be sharing our interview.

Narrative - Mccracken, Joel - 3/27/2024 9:23:44 AM (Initial)

I have reached out again to the state police crimes against children. Andrea Burns stated that the director of the center still has not returned any of her calls with regards to the video footage. She tried reaching out again on 3/19/24 with no response. According to the victim all of these actions are believed to have taken place off camera and over the course of some time. It is likely that at this point that no camera footage from December when this event took place is even saved. Bono Pd Did not hear about this incident till 2/11/24.

[REDACTED] had contact the police department to let us know that the Victim had sent her a message on facebook from someone else account wanting to talk to her. She was instructed to block the account and screen shot the message.

I have tried to contact [REDACTED] a few times to inform her of the prosecutors office decision not to go forward with charges at this time. I was unable reach her. I did leave her a voice mail informing her of their decision.
