On Wednesday, 02/21/2024 at approximately 1612 hours I made contact with Demetria Spearman (B/F DOB: 11/12/1996) over the phone in reference to an Assault/Battery report she wished to file. Demetria is an employee at the Perimeter of the Ozarks Behavioral Health Unit at 2466 S 48th St B. Demetria stated she was attacked by one of the juvenile females that is a patient/resident identified as [REDACTED] (W/F 15yoa).

Demetria stated on Tuesday, 02/20/2024 at approximately 1445 hours she was tending to other residents when [REDACTED] became uncooperative and aggressive towards her while she was trying to get them in their secured rooms. She said [REDACTED] attacked her by pulling her hair and hit her in the face several times. Other employees assisted in separating [REDACTED] from her. Demetria said she did not have any marks or injuries from the attack. She said she was advised by her employer she could file a Police report for the incident to have documentation. I provided her with the report number and advised her to call if she had any questions or further information.
