Report Description: [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED] out of state [REDACTED] DCFS) Description of report: At approx. 0830 on 2/20/24 staff reported that resident was having an allergic reaction in the gym. Nurse found resident laying down, face up, she was breathing but not responding to verbal stimuli. EpiPen was administered, and EMS was called. Patient was taken via EMS to Arkansas's Childrens Hospital in Springdale under an abundance of caution. She was assessed at the hospital, was given IV fluids. The physician did not think it was an allergic reaction. She returned to facility and will follow-up with APRN here on 02/21/2024.

Licensing Narrative: 2/22/2024 - The provider reported incident was review by licensing specialist Jarred Parnell. 2/26/2024 - The following correspondence was received from the facility in regards to the incident, She saw APRN on 2/21 Subjective Pt reported a food allergy to berries on admit. She had an episode in the cafeteria on j2-20-24 with syncopal episodes and was sent to ER. ACH declined an "allergic reaction response" but no documentation to support. Mother and DHS declined a history of food allergies. She reports these people "know nothing about me." She looks

good. She is febrile with no chills, rash, or n/v She denies swelling of her throat and no difficulty chewing or swallowing food.
