As the client was walking back to the house she got out of line walked up to her peer and grabbed her butt inappropriately. After grabbing her butt she proceeded to slap her on the butt. The other client turned around in disbelief. I then told the Client to step out of line to talk to her about her actions. I told her that she will be facing consequences when she get back to the house. Additional Notes: The [REDACTED] was also contacted after I contacted the nurse, ct. and the UM. I spoke with Mariah Thomas about the incident over the phone. She sent me a referral number for the client that was touched. The referral was accepted [REDACTED]

Interim Action Narrative: Hotline called and accepted.

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Maltreatment Narrative: AV is [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Out of home offender is [REDACTED]. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are residents at the Youth Home in Little Rock, AR. The current concern is regarding an incident that occurred on the way back from lunch (02/25/24). [REDACTED] reportedly walked up to [REDACTED] groped her on the butt without her consent. The grope did seem to be for [REDACTED] sexual gratification. The two stay in the same residential house, but

provisions have been put in place. They are not going to have access to each other and must remain 6 feet apart.

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Licensing Narrative: Program Coordinator reviewed complaint for licensing concerns. Program Coordinator requested permission from investigator to contact facility. Investigator Johnson requested for Program Coordinator to wait to contact the facility until after she interview the AV. Program Coordinator will inquire about peer's consequences. 2/28/2024, Program Coordinator followed up with facility on peer's consequences. Investigator Johnson informed Program Coordinator that she interviewed the resident who reported that her and peer were horseplaying and no harm was done. Investigator Johnson reported that case would most likely be found unsubstantiated. 3/25/2024, Program Coordinator inquired about status of case. 3/26/2024, Investigator Johnson informed Program Coordinator that case would be found unsubstantiated but was not closed yet. 3/29/2024, Program Coordinator checked [REDACTED] case still pending. 4/5/2024, Licensing informed case found unsubstantiated.
