Patient then reported to nurse which provided assessment and comfort measures and monitoring. Bruising developed overnight and new orders to have patient evaluated at urgent care. Nursing Assessment date/time: 03/03/24 10:32am: Patient presents at nurse station with complaint of sore left hand #2 finger. Patient was playing ball yesterday and a ball hit her finger. Today Pt finger presents with swelling and bruising. Cap refill is brisk at distal aspect. Pt reports palpation a tender and sore. Pt able to demonstrate active ROM but soreness present.
