Forehead was damp with perspirations. Patient laid on the ground with shallow breathing and nurse was alerted to respond to assess. Nursing Assessment date/time: 03/03/24 6:10pm: Patient presents on grass field laying supine position with staff present. Pt minimally responsive to questions. Not alert and oriented to person place time or event. Pt states "I'm weak with body aches, I'm cold, I can't sit up." Pt vitals upon first interaction was Pulse 141, BP 138/88, Respirations 14/min. Pupils equal reactive to light and accommodation. Unable to track finger through visual fields. Pt unable to perform hand squeez Neuro checks for strength. Pt sat up by staff to assist in breathing, after five minutes patient escorted with assistance to house. While at house BP and pulse constant monitoring performed and Pulse and BP declined to unremarkable ranges. Pt became totally unresponsive to questioning of staff and mems notified and pulse ox and breathing monitored constantly. O2 sat ranged from 90-98's. Patient received by mems service and remained unresponsive throughout care while visible. Ambulance personal provided patient information and transported Pt to ACH for evaluation. Guardian was contacted on 03/03/24 at 6:16pm returned to the Youth Home Campus sometime in the evening on 03/03/24 ER Paperwork has been emailed to Kendra Rice on 03/04/24
