#### Description:

On March 7, 2024 at approximately 2100 hours I, Officer Springston 386, responded to a disturbance at 2466 S. 48th Street (Perimeter of the Ozarks). An officer was on scene and requested additional units to respond due to there being a physical fight between at least four juvenile females.

Upon arrival, Officer Miller 395 had two female juveniles identified as, [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) and [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]), detained for physically attacking another juvenile patient. Staff members stated that they were attacking an eleven-year-old female. They stated that there were injuries but none that required medical response. I interviewed the victim who was identified as [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]). [REDACTED] stated that she had gotten upset and broke some crayons and [REDACTED] had taken her notebook and was kicking it.

At that time [REDACTED] had gotten up and went to a staff member that was in the room and stated that she felt unsafe. The staff member instructed [REDACTED] to stand behind him. At this time [REDACTED] was prancing down the hall way to another group of girls. It is unknown what [REDACTED] said to the girls but she claimed that she was telling the other girls that [REDACTED] was writing love notes about her. As [REDACTED] walked away and went into her room, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] walked down the hall to the common area where the staff member and [REDACTED] were and began attacking [REDACTED]. [REDACTED], while facing [REDACTED], grasped her by her hair causing her head to be pointed to the ceiling and punched her in the face and threw her to the ground.

At this point [REDACTED] was on the ground with her back on [REDACTED]'s stomach and her legs between [REDACTED]'s. [REDACTED] then begins punching [REDACTED] as well as [REDACTED] has her wrapped up with her legs and arms. The staff member gets [REDACTED] away from the fight but [REDACTED] still had [REDACTED] wrapped up between her legs. Moments after the staff member

removed [REDACTED] from the altercation, [REDACTED] came from room and forcefully kicked [REDACTED] on her left leg, while she was still wrapped up by [REDACTED].

There is a visible red mark and purple/ blue bruise on the area that [REDACTED] kicked [REDACTED] approximately three inches long. Staff members were showed the injury that [REDACTED] sustained on her leg and they stated that the bruise and red markings were not there previously. [REDACTED] also had red marks on her arms and legs presumably where [REDACTED] had her wrapped. Her face was also red and discolored where [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had punched her. [REDACTED] did not make physical contact or hit anyone back during the altercation.

Washington County Juvenile Intake was contacted around 2230 hours and informed officers that they would take custody of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED]'s set court date is 03/08/2024 at 0915. Intake stated that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]'s court dates would be provided to them once they arrive at the jail.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were transported to Arkansas Children's Hospital for suicidal ideations. Which a staff member informed me that was a premeditated plan that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated they were going to do. [REDACTED] was arrested a transported to the juvenile section of the Springdale Jail. Jail staff transported [REDACTED] from Springdale jail and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] directly from Arkansas Children's hospital to Washington County Juvenile Detention Center.

On 3/7/2024, at approximately 7:05 pm, Cpl. Abernathy and I were dispatched to an Assault & Battery (Just Occurred) located at 2466 S 48th St B. Springdale, AR. 72762. This location is known as The Perimeter of the Ozarks, which is a residential facility to meet the needs of adolescent females who have been impacted by trauma.

Upon arrival, I made contact with the caller (lead nurse/supervisor, Shantel), who stated there had been a sixteen-year-old female [REDACTED] (W/F DOB: [REDACTED]) who had been slowly getting agitated and aggressive all day and had just attacked an eleven-year-old. Shantel stated, "It was unprovoked." Shantel also noted two other females, [REDACTED] (W/F DOB: [REDACTED]) and [REDACTED] (W/F DOB: [REDACTED]), were also battering the eleven-year-old.

Myself and Cpl. Abernathy requested to speak to the victim, [REDACTED] (W/F DOB: [REDACTED]). While interviewing [REDACTED], she explained she had gotten upset about something (unintelligible) and had broken some crayons. When she did, other girls jumped on her and hit, kicked, and pulled her hair. I asked her if she needed medical attention, and she said no. I asked her where she was hit, and she showed me her left hamstring, which had slight bruising, and her left arm, which also had slight bruising. She also showed me an area of her head with a slight bump. (see pictures)

I then asked to speak with the primary aggressor, [REDACTED]. One of the first things I asked was what was going on today and if she stated, "I had pounced on someone today." [REDACTED] said, "Yeah."

Cpl. Abernathy asked [REDACTED] to tell her side of the story. [REDACTED] said, "I fought a girl because my friend didn't like her because she was writing love letters to my friend." She explained that she attacked the girl by the table and that after they fought, another girl, [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]), jumped in and kicked her. I dismissed her, and she went back inside the locked area.

At this point, I had the situation under control, and Cpl. Abernathy left the scene. Next, I wanted to interview the second suspect, [REDACTED] (W/F DOB: [REDACTED]). I asked [REDACTED] to tell me her side of the story, and she stated, "This little girl named [REDACTED] was writing love notes to one of the residents here; they're like fifteen, and they didn't like it." As she further explained her side of the story, an altercation erupted. She stated, [REDACTED] grabbed her hair and started beating her, and I jumped in and started hitting her." I dismissed her, and she went back inside the locked area.

As I continued to investigate, Supervisor Shantel stated that a third subject was part of the fight. Her name is [REDACTED] (W/F DOB: [REDACTED]). I requested to speak with [REDACTED], who stated she only accidentally kicked [REDACTED] and apologized to her. I dismissed her, and she went back inside the locked area.

Please note that all parties agreed to be calm without further issues. While waiting for the video to download, I called the Juvenile Detention Center (JDC) an on-call Intake Officer, Stephanie Thomas, to gather additional information about the evening's future procedures. I also attempted to call all three suspects' legal guardians.

I was unable to contact [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. While I continued making further phone calls and voicemails, a fight/altercation erupted inside the locked, secured area. During the eruption, staff was unable to communicate any facts concerning aggressors, facts, victim's injuries, or possible weapons. After the scene was calm, I went back to further communicate with JDC and Legal Guardians. Again, a fight/altercation was issued; I re-entered the secure area and placed handcuffs on [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] while checking for proper fitting and then double-locking them. Both females were placed in the back of my patrol car. While doing so, [REDACTED] stated she wanted to kill herself. I requested the Springdale Fire Department for a medical evaluation. Upon their arrival and the transport to Arkansas Children's Hospital for a suicidal evaluation, [REDACTED] stated the same thing. "I want to kill myself."

I transported [REDACTED] to Arkansas Children's Hospital. I requested to have Arkansas Children's Hospital admit [REDACTED] for a suicidal evaluation. In the end, [REDACTED] was cleared to be released by Daniel Pevril, CNP, and [REDACTED] was placed on a Suicide Hold by an "Unknown Provider." After speaking with JDC, they confirmed receiving both parties for charges.

Let it be noted that I was never able to watch a complete "Video Evidence" of the altercation; however, when other officers arrived, a supervisor and Officer Springston did. Due to the totality of the circumstances, "Perimeter of the Ozarks staff witnesses, video footage, suspect's admissions of guilt." It is obvious three females, [REDACTED] (W/F DOB: [REDACTED]), [REDACTED] (AKA: [REDACTED]) (W/F DOB: [REDACTED]), [REDACTED] (W/F DOB: [REDACTED]) bullied, and ganged-up an attacked on [REDACTED] (W/F DOB: [REDACTED]) to cause physical injury to [REDACTED] by beating her up with visible injuries. It should also be noted that [REDACTED] is eleven years old and under twelve. The statute 5-13-202(a)(1)(C) states this as a Felony.
