She was expected to be having an allergic reaction to a new antibiotic she had just started (Doxycycline). [REDACTED] was ordered to be sent out to Baptist Crittenden ER for further evaluation. Resident was returned to Perimeter and Doxycycline was discontinued. Resident has a follow up appointment scheduled Wednesday and Arkansas health center.
