On 03/15/2024, at approximately 7:53 AM, I, Officer Y. Chavez #344 and Ofc. D. Kimbro #252 responded to a call at 600 North 7th Street, at Perimeter Behavioral Health Center, in reference to three juveniles running away from the facility.

Upon arrival, I made contact with the complainant, Latasha Davis, who advised that three [REDACTED] juveniles ran away from the facility and crossed North 7th Street towards an open field. During my search of the open field, I did not observe the three juveniles, and that is when the employees from the facility advised to me that they observed the [REDACTED] juveniles running through the yards of residences in the area of West McAuley Drive.

We then searched the area of West McAuley Drive and surrounding neighborhoods for the three juveniles, but were unable to locate them. We searched the area, including open sheds and vacant residences for approximately 30 minutes. We observed the facility workers running towards the backyard of 508 Weaver Road and that is when I observed the three [REDACTED] attempting to run again. During my interaction with the subjects, later identified as [REDACTED], and [REDACTED], and arrestee, [REDACTED], they kept yelling profanity at Officers and facility workers. They also made comments saying that we might as well shoot them and continued to yell out other obscenities. While trying to escort them to the patrol units, they kept jerking away from Officers and continued to yell out obscenities, making it difficult to keep control of them. Once we got them into the units they began banging their heads against the cage in an attempt to harm themselves.

[REDACTED] head butted and kicked the right front fender of Unit #2172 causing a dent. When [REDACTED] was placed in Unit #2169 where [REDACTED] continued to head butt the partition causing a cut on [REDACTED] forehead. WMFD EMS was called to the scene and treated [REDACTED] for minor injuries to [REDACTED] forehead.
