Description:

On Saturday, 03/16/2024 at approximately 1512 hours I arrived on scene of an Assault/Battery Call at 2466 S 48th St (Perimeter of the Ozarks). Caller advised a 12 yoa resident by the name [REDACTED] was assaulting staff members and had to be physically restrained.

Upon my arrival I made contact with the lead nurse who advised me she attacked another resident and several staff members. I asked if it had been occurring throughout the day and she advised it only just occurred. She advised she was being physically restrained. She escorted Officer Baker (318) and I inside to where [REDACTED] was being restrained by four different staff members. They were holding her down by each limb and she was laying flat on her back. Once we arrived, they released [REDACTED] and she sat up. I attempted to talk to her to see what the problem was and why she was behaving in such an aggressive manner. She said that she was attacked by another resident and she did not know who it was. She said once she was attacked she began fighting other residents and then hit a male staff member because she does not like the male gender.

I grabbed a handful of witness statement forms out of my car and each staff member wanting to press charges for being assaulted completed one. I was told that she attacked at least six different staff members and battered one by leaving bloody scratch marks on their head and



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arms.

The first statement was from Andrew Blocker (W/M [REDACTED]). He advised he was called to assist with [REDACTED] once she was getting out of control. He said as he was trying to assist in blocking the unit door and moving a desk out of the room his back was turned towards [REDACTED] and she punched the back of his neck and shoulder two to three times. Andrew did not report any pain and did not have any marks or bruising.

The second statement from America Mejia (H/F [REDACTED]) states she was called to replace the lead staff member and [REDACTED] had tried scratching at her and attempting to bite her while she was being restrained.

The third statement from Erika Ingram (B/F [REDACTED]) states [REDACTED] was threatening to hit the nurse with a dust pan. She was also verbally threatening to hit staff members. Erika said she began pushing several staff members and she intervened. When doing so [REDACTED] punched her several times. When they were able to physically restrain her, [REDACTED] kicked her in her stomach.

The fourth statement from Ronesha Oliver (B/F [REDACTED]) states she was attempting to stop [REDACTED] from attacking another staff member. She said when doing so, [REDACTED] charged at her and began grabbing and pulling her hair. She told her several times to let go of her and she refused. Other staff members had to pry her hair out of [REDACTED] hand.

The fifth statement from Shawn Brown (W/M [REDACTED]) states he was called to assist other staff when a resident was acting out. He said he watched [REDACTED] hitting another staff member. Shawn states he had to restrain [REDACTED] and she hit him in the head in the process. Once she was taken to the ground she started digging her nails into his skin causing fresh cuts that were bleeding.

I asked Shawn and the lead staff member to take photographs of the injuries. They were sent to



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my email and later uploaded to Evidence.com. I contacted the Juvenile Detention Center in Washington County and reported the incident. [REDACTED] was being charged with four counts of Assault 2nd and one count of Battery 3rd. I was informed that JDC was going to detain [REDACTED] based on Perimeter of the Ozarks wanting her removed from the facility and [REDACTED] was a ward of the State of Texas. There was nobody else to relinquish custody of [REDACTED] to. I placed her in handcuffs checking for fit and double lock. I transported her to the Springdale Jail where I completed a Juvenile Preliminary report. I then transported her to Washington County JDC where she was turned over to jail staff.

My BWC was activated. BDB 363
