On 03/21/2024 at approximately 8:02 pm, I was dispatched to the Perimeter of the Ozarks located at 2466 S 48th St B in Springdale, Arkansas, for an assault/battery that had just occurred. This facility houses adolescent girls who have been impacted by trauma.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with the staff, who stated that [REDACTED] (B/F [REDACTED]) jumped on another resident and began hitting her. While I was speaking to the staff, Officer Dickerson made contact with [REDACTED]. When asked by Officer Dickerson what happened, [REDACTED] stated she jumped on the victim and, with a closed fist, hit the victim in the back of the head, pulled her hair, and stomped on her. Video footage confirmed the above-mentioned statement given by [REDACTED].

I spoke with the victim, [REDACTED] (W/F [REDACTED]) and asked her what happened. [REDACTED] said she was talking to herself and the other girls thought she was talking about them. Then [REDACTED] got on top of her and began hitting her and pulling her hair. I asked [REDACTED] if it hurt and she said yes. I could see slight redness on the top of [REDACTED] head. I also noticed self-inflicted wounds on [REDACTED] forearms. However, there was visible redness and in the area of the wounds. I took pictures of both her head and arms and uploaded them to Axon Capture.

I also spoke with a staff member by the name of Sherrill McKenna who said she witnessed the battery. Ms. McKenna said the [REDACTED] had been agitated all day and for no apparent reason attacked [REDACTED] by jumping on her, hitting her and pulling her hair. Ms. McKenna filled out a witness statement and is attached to this case.

Due to the victim's statement, the witnesses on the scene, video footage, and [REDACTED] own confession, I am placing [REDACTED] under arrest for purposely causing physical injury to another person, and because the victim is under the age of twelve, this is upgraded from a battery third to a battery 2nd degree which is a felony.

I contacted Juvenile Intake and spoke with Samantha Cox who advised that they would be detaining [REDACTED]. Samantha stated that [REDACTED] would have a court date of March 22, 2024 at 0830 AM at division 3 with Judge Zimmerman. [REDACTED] was issued a citation (24-17163) for Battery 2nd Degree which was turned over along with her property to Juvenile intake.

Officer Dickerson was advised that I had probable cause for Battery 2nd Degree and placed [REDACTED] under arrest. Officer Dickerson transported [REDACTED] to Juvenile Intake where she was turned over to the on-duty staff for further processing.

I contacted the Arkansas Child Abuse Hotline Mandatory Reporting Portal and submitted a case file. The confirmation code is (223643326).
