Description:

On March 28th, 2024 at approximately 6:03PM, I, Officer Sysavanh #389, responded to a disturbance call on 2466 South 48th St #B Springdale, AR (Perimeter of the Ozarks Behavioral of the Ozarks).

Upon arrival, I made contact with staff who lead us into the facility and back behind the westside of the building. There was a female juvenile being restrained on the ground by four staff members. I later identified the female juvenile as [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]). The victim, later identified as [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]), stated [REDACTED] was trying to escape the facility by climbing the fence that was surrounding the perimeter. [REDACTED] stopped [REDACTED] by grabbing her shoulder to prevent her from climbing the fence any further. [REDACTED] jumped off the fence and punched her in the left eye and broke her glasses. [REDACTED] pulled on the [REDACTED]'s hair till other staff members were able to assist in restraining her.

I handcuffed and detained [REDACTED], checked for tightness and double-locked the cuffs. I moved [REDACTED] to an isolation holding room. I removed the handcuffs while [REDACTED] was in the room so she could change out of her ripped clothing. I handcuffed [REDACTED] again after she changed into new clothes provided by staff. I checked for tightness and double-locked the cuffs.

I observed slight swelling [REDACTED] left eye. I photographed multiple pictures of [REDACTED] and her broken glasses through Axon Capture application. [REDACTED] notified me that the glasses were valued at \$195. I contacted Washington County Juvenile Intake and provided information regarding [REDACTED]. [REDACTED]'s guardian is the state of Idaho with a case worker, Trisa Dunbar, assigned to her. I attempted to contact her case worker several times by phone without success. Washington County Juvenile Detention Center gave the juvenile an arraignment date of 03/29/2024 at 8:15AM. Officer Barron #399 transported [REDACTED] to Washington County Juvenile Detention Center. I completed an e-cite for [REDACTED] giving her a court date of 03/29/2024 at 8:15AM at 123 North College Fayetteville, AR.
