

Program Coordinator Rice and Licensing Specialist Norton accompanied Investigator Dominique Rudley to review camera footage.

Licensing observed resident and staff in the milieu. Licensing could hear a staff member requesting resident to stop and let go of the key. Resident was observed grabbing at a staff member's wrist that was in a brace. The staff member was heard several times requesting for resident to let go of her arm/wrist.

Resident informed staff member that she was going to tell. Staff was heard stating, "I don't give a shit who you tell." The staff member was observed trying to move away from resident and the resident kept following behind the staff member. Other staff members were observed trying to keep the resident from the staff member.

Resident was observed running down the hallway with the staff member's keys out of camera view with her shirt off. Staff ran behind the resident to get the keys. Staff returned to the milieu and allowed resident time to calm down. A staff member was observed walking down the hallway with the resident's shirt. Resident then returned to the milieu and starting swinging what appeared to be a jacket at staff.

Facility reported that resident came back from acute placement on 3/13/2024, Staff member mentioned in this maltreatment/complaint was off from work 3/13/2024 to 3/15/2024. Staff member returned to work on 3/18/2024 and was out again from 3/19/2024 to 3/22/2024.

Facility reported that upon return, the staff member involved will be retrained on verbal de-escalation. Facility will be cited for 905.4.c, staff member used obscene language toward a resident.

Provider Comments:

While we acknowledge that there was an unfortunate use of crude language there are two issues we need to point out. First there are extenuating circumstances that we feel should be considered. The youth in this situation was actively attempting to inflict injury on the staff by grabbing the staff members already injured wrist. The staff member was trying to escape the grip and was in obvious discomfort if not significant pain. A small slip in terms of language in such a circumstance while not acceptable, would certainly seem to be mitigated by the severity of the assualt and pain inflicted.

Secondly in looking at the citation the regulation listed does not match the wording of the MLS found on the DHS website. Per that publication 905.4. reads as follows: "4. The following disciplinary actions shall not be used: c. Lewd or obscene language;" The languaged used was not part of any disciplinary action. This was an utterance that apparently resulted from pain and possibly frustration at being assualted. The staff member clearly instructed the client to let go, then asked her to please let go before pulling away and making the comment. The comment in itself was in no way disciplianry and did not involve any potential consequence regarding the child's behavior. We would therefore respectfully request that this citation be reconsidered and removed from the record.
